## **RESOLUTION AND ORDER**

On July 13, 2022, the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board ("Energy Bureau") issued a Resolution and Order ("July 13 Resolution"), through which it initiated the above captioned investigation pertaining a power outage in the municipality of Jayuya that occurred on July 12, 2022 ("July 12 Incident").

Moreover, through the July 13 Resolution, the Energy Bureau ordered LUMA,<sup>1</sup> amongst other things, to submit a preliminary report on the causes of the July 12 Incident and the corrective actions taken by LUMA, on or before July 19, 2022, at 3:00 p.m.

On July 15, 2022, LUMA filed before the Energy Bureau a document titled *Request for a Brief Extension of Time to Comply with July 13<sup>th</sup> Resolution and Order on July 12<sup>th</sup> Incident Investigation* ("July 15 Motion"). Through the July 15 Motion, LUMA stated that it had been working to comply with the July 13 Resolution by the deadline imposed.<sup>2</sup> However, according to LUMA, additional analysis and drafting is needed to submit a correct and comprehensive preliminary report to aid the Energy Bureau in its investigation.<sup>3</sup> LUMA estimated it will need an additional two days to comply with the July 13 Resolution.<sup>4</sup> Accordingly, LUMA requested the Energy Bureau to take notice of the aforementioned and grant LUMA until July 21, 2022, at the end of the day, to comply with the July 13 Resolution.<sup>5</sup>

The Energy Bureau **GRANTS** LUMA's request and **ORDERS** LUMA to file a preliminary report on the causes of the July 12 Incident and the corrective actions taken by the same, on or before July 21, 2022, at the end of the day.

The Energy Bureau **WARNS** LUMA that, noncompliance with any provisions of this Resolution and Order, may result in the imposition of fines pursuant to Act 57-2014<sup>6</sup> and any other administrative sanctions, as deemed appropriate by the Energy Bureau.
