RESOLUTION


On August 10, 2022, the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board ("Energy Bureau") issued a Resolution and Order through which it scheduled a Technical Conference for September 23, 2022, to discuss relevant issues for a wheeling services agreement.


On September 15, 2022, LUMA Energy, LLC and LUMA Energy ServCo, LLC ("LUMA") filed before the Energy Bureau a document titled *Request to Postpone the Technical Conference of September 23, 2022* ("September 15 Motion"). Through the September 15 Motion, LUMA requested the Energy Bureau to continue or re-schedule the September 23, 2022 Technical Conference for the week of November 7, 2022, and at least one month after the Energy Bureau approves or issues an agenda for the Technical Conference so LUMA will be afforded time to prepare.¹ LUMA indicated that pending parallel technical conferences and filing deadlines in multiple proceedings before the Energy Bureau conflicted with the September 23, 2022 Technical Conference.² LUMA further stated that an agenda had not yet been issued by the Energy Bureau in the instant proceeding.³

Upon review of the September 15 Motion, and taking notice that LUMA and the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority ("PREPA") are focused in restoring the electric system due to the impact caused by hurricane Fiona, the Energy Bureau **RESCHEDULES** the Technical Conference for **Friday, October 21, 2022** (from 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.).

The Agenda for the October 21, 2022 Technical Conference is included as part of this Resolution and Order.
