**MOTION REQUESTING AUTHORIZATION TO UTILIZE AN OFFICIAL COURT
REPORTER DURING EVIDENTIARY HEARING**

TO THE HONORABLE PUERTO RICO ENERGY BUREAU:

COME now **LUMA Energy, LLC** (“ManagementCo”), and **LUMA Energy ServCo, LLC** (“ServCo”), (jointly referred to as the “Operator” or “LUMA”), and respectfully state and request the following:

1. On January 30, 2023, the Puerto Rico Energy Bureau (“Energy Bureau”) issued a Resolution which included, as Attachment A, a Hybrid Evidentiary Hearing Protocol detailing various aspects of how the evidentiary hearing scheduled for next week will be conducted. Among the topics discussed therein was the recording of the hearing and the official record. In Section VI, the Energy Bureau expressly states that “...a party or their counsel may keep an official court reporter to make an official record of the proceeding upon the Energy Bureau's permission.” See Section VI, Recording of Hearing and Official Record of the *Hybrid Evidentiary Hearing Protocol*.

2. In compliance with Section VI, Recording of Hearing and Official Record of the *Hybrid Evidentiary Hearing Protocol*, LUMA hereby requests authorization to utilize an official

court reporter to prepare an official record of the Evidentiary Hearing scheduled for February 7-10, 2023.

WHEREFORE, LUMA respectfully requests that the Energy Bureau **takes note of the aforementioned** and **authorize** LUMA to utilize an official court reporter during the Evidentiary Hearing.
