
**RESOLUTION AND ORDER**

On August 6, 2021, the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board (“Energy Bureau”) issued a Resolution and Order (“August 6 Resolution”) through which it ordered the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority (“PREPA”) to amend the Streetlighting Manual to include only the essential physical and functional features and delete any specific reference to a brand. The August 6 Resolution stated that PREPA shall abstain from including a specific brand in the final version of the codes and standards unless there is an extraordinary or special circumstance that makes it necessary to include such information.

The Energy Bureau hereby **ORDERS** PREPA to inform the status of the amendment on the Streetlighting Manual and submit it on or before **May 18, 2023**.
