**SUBJECT: Urgent Request for Extension to Submit Information in Compliance with Resolution and Order dated May 18, 2023**

**URGENT REQUEST FOR EXTENSION TO SUBMIT INFORMATION IN COMPLIANCE WITH RESOLUTION AND ORDER DATED MAY 18, 2023**

**TO THE HONORABLE PUERTO RICO ENERGY BUREAU:**

COME NOW LUMA Energy, LLC (“ManagementCo”), and LUMA Energy ServCo, LLC (“ServCo”), (jointly referred to as “LUMA”), and respectfully submit the following in compliance with the Energy Bureau’s Resolution and Order dated May 18, 2023:

1. On May 15, 2023, LUMA submitted to this Puerto Rico Energy Bureau (the “Energy Bureau”) the proposed Budgets for the Puerto Rico Energy System (the “System”), which are comprised of the proposed budget for the Transmission and Distribution System (“Proposed Annual T&D Budgets”), developed by LUMA; the budget proposal for the legacy thermal generation units (the “GenCo Budget”), the budget proposal for the hydroelectric generating units and the public irrigation facilities (the “HydroCo Budget”) and the budget proposal for PREPA and its subsidiaries other than GenCo and HydroCo (the, “HoldCo Budget”) (collectively referred to as the “System Annual Budgets”). *See Submission of Consolidated Annual Budgets for Fiscal Year 2024 and Annual T&D Projections through Fiscal Year 2026* filed in this proceeding (“FY2024 Consolidated Budgets Submission”).

2. On May 18, 2023, the Energy Bureau entered a Resolution and Order whereby it ordered PREPA, through LUMA, to submit detailed HydroCo and HoldCo Operating and Capital

Expenditures Budgets that “reflect[] the LUMA Budget Request in Schedule 3.1 entitled “Annual Budget Summary” with all the supporting documentation used to substantiate the request[s].” *See* May 18<sup>th</sup> Order, page 2.

3. The Energy Bureau further ordered Genera to submit, through LUMA, a “detailed GenCo Operating and Capital Expenditures Budgets that reflects the LUMA Budget Request in Schedule 3.1 with all the supporting documentation used to substantiate the request.” *Id.*

4. It is informed that LUMA has been in communication with counsels for Genera PREPA to comply with the May 18<sup>th</sup> Order.

5. Today, sister counsel for PREPA informed that PREPA will be seeking by separate motion to be filed by PREPA, an extension of time to comply with the May 18<sup>th</sup> Order.

6. It is further informed that today, counsel for Genera informed the undersigned that although Genera has been working diligently to comply with the May 18<sup>th</sup> Order by today at noon, Genera requires an extension until today at 6:00 p.m. to finalize its submission to this Energy Bureau in compliance with the May 18<sup>th</sup> Order.

7. Given the aforementioned, LUMA is not in a position to submit by noon today, Genera’s information on the GenCo Operating and Capital Expenditures Budget and supporting documentation, as this Energy Bureau required in the May 18<sup>th</sup> Order. It is clarified that LUMA is not participating in the development of the information that Genera will submit to this Energy Bureau in compliance with the May 18<sup>th</sup> Order.

**WHEREFORE**, LUMA respectfully requests that the Energy Bureau **take notice** of this Urgent Request; and **grant** Genera, through LUMA, until 6:00 p.m. today, to comply with the May 18<sup>th</sup> Order as it pertains to Genera and the GenCo Operating and Capital Expenditures Budget.
