SUBJECT: Resolution pertaining to *Motion Requesting Extension of Time to File Replies to Final Briefs by the Parties*, filed by LUMA Energy, LLC and LUMA Energy ServCo, LLC.

RESOLUTION

On May 22, 2023, LUMA¹ filed before the Energy Bureau of the Public Service Regulatory Board (“Energy Bureau”) a document titled *Motion Requesting Extension of Time to File Replies to Final Briefs by the Parties* (“May 22 Motion”). In its May 22 Motion, LUMA indicated that it was concurrently working on the replies to the briefs filed by LECO² and ICPO³ and working with PREPA⁴ to stipulate the transcripts of the Evidentiary Hearing.⁵ According to LUMA, such a process involves revising the transcripts against audio to confirm any proposed corrections that need to be made, being a very time-consuming task.⁶ Moreover, LUMA highlighted that, unlike the other parties in the proceeding, it had to file replies to LECO and ICPO’s final briefs.⁷ LUMA maintained such endeavors were highly challenging to complete in three weeks, considering that it needed to reply to two very extensive briefs.⁸ LUMA also mentioned that the Energy Bureau had scheduled a hearing for June 9, 2023 in another proceeding in which LUMA and the undersigned counsel will participate.⁹

In view of the above, LUMA stated that the June 1, 2023 deadline to submit the replies to the final briefs by the parties should be extended until at least June 22, 2023.¹⁰ LUMA also requested that the remaining deadline in the procedural calendar be rescheduled accordingly.¹¹

Upon review of the May 22 Motion, the Energy Bureau **GRANTS** LUMA’s request to amend the procedural calendar and **AMENDS** the procedural calendar of the instant case as follows:

June 29, 2023	Filing of Comments by General Public Due, Filing of Final Brief by <i>Amicus Curiae</i>
