SUBJECT: Resolution pertaining to *Notice of Intent to Submit Reply to Urgent Request Filed by Punta Lima on June 6, 2023,* filed by LUMA Energy, LLC and LUMA Energy ServCo, LLC.

RESOLUTION

On June 6, 2023, Punta Lima Wind Farm, LLC ("Punta Lima") filed before the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board ("Energy Bureau") a document titled *Urgent Request for Order to Execute Power Purchase and Operating Agreement, a Decision on the Interconnection Agreement, and for Confidential Treatment of Information* ("June 6 Motion"). In its June 6 Motion, Punta Lima alleged that it has been unable to take the foregoing steps pertaining to the testing and commissioning of its wind turbines because the Power Purchase and Operating Agreement ("PPOA") between the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority ("PREPA") and Punta Lima has yet to be executed and due to certain material differences that remain between LUMA Energy, LLC and LUMA Energy ServCo, LLC (jointly referred to as "LUMA") and Punta Lima regarding the Interconnection Agreement ("IA").¹ Thus, Punta Lima requested that the Energy Bureau order the execution of the referenced PPOA and issue a determination on the IA.²

On June 8, 2023, LUMA filed with the Energy Bureau a document titled *Notice of Intent to Submit Reply to Urgent Request Filed by Punta Lima on June 6, 2023* ("June 8 Motion"). Through its June 8 Motion, LUMA indicated that it had additional statements to make before the Energy Bureau decides with respect to the differences between Punta Lima and LUMA relating to the IA.³ LUMA further stated that it was in the process of preparing a response to Punta Lima's June 6 Motion, which it anticipates will be filed on or before June 13, 2023.⁴ LUMA also highlighted the need for the Energy Bureau to review LUMA's forthcoming response and for the parties to have an opportunity to be heard in a confidential technical meeting or conference before any resolution is reached. Accordingly, LUMA requested that the Energy Bureau grant until June 13, 2023 to submit its response to the June 6 Motion.⁵

Upon review of the June 8 Motion, the Energy Bureau **GRANTS** LUMA until **Tuesday**, **June 13**, **2023** to file its response to the June 6 Motion.
