**SUBJECT:** Motion in compliance with Resolution and Order of May 10, 2023, and request for confidential treatment of information.

**RESOLUTION**

On May 10, 2023, the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board (“Energy Bureau”) issued a Resolution and Order (“May 10 Order”), in which it ordered CEN JUNCOS SOLAR, LLC ( “CEN Juncos Solar”), within fifteen (15) days from the notification of the May 10 Order, to file: (i) the compiled financial statements certified by an Authorized Public Accountant (CPA) authorized to practice such profession in Puerto Rico or in any jurisdiction of the United States of America pursuant to the provisions of Section 4.02 of Regulation 8701,<sup>1</sup> and; (ii) evidence of electronic payment of eight hundred dollars (\$800) of the filling of the Operational Report<sup>2</sup>.

On May 22, 2023, CEN Juncos Solar filed a document titled *Motion in Compliance with Resolution and Order notified on May 10, 2023, and Request for Confidential Treatment of Information* (“May 22 Motion”), with the following attachments:

- (1) *Gross Revenue and Financial Statements Report Electric Companies (Form NEPR-B05).*
- (2) *CEN JUNCOS SOLAR, LLC 2022 Income Statements.*
- (3) *Evidence of the Wire Transfer for the payment of the Operational Report Fees.*

In the May 22 Motion, CEN Juncos Solar requested confidential treatment to the information presented in the Gross Revenues and Financial Statements Form, the financial statements, and the banking information (“Confidential Documents”). CEN Juncos Solar argues that the information for which they request protection is of confidential nature and is not publicly available, therefore its public dissemination will place CEN Juncos Solar at a competitive disadvantage regarding others market participants and cause CEN Juncos Solar economic harm.<sup>3</sup>

Act No. 57-2014<sup>4</sup> establishes that any person having the obligation to submit information to the Energy Bureau, may request that any information deemed privileged or confidential be treated in such fashion.<sup>5</sup> Specifically, Act 57-2014 requires the Energy Bureau to treat as confidential the information submitted provided that “after the appropriate evaluation, believes such information should be protected” and in such case, “the Energy Bureau shall grant such protection in a manner that least affects the public interest, transparency, and the

rights of the parties involved in the administrative procedure in which the allegedly confidential documents are submitted.<sup>6</sup>



The Energy Bureau **ACKNOWLEDGES** the evidence presented by CEN Juncos Solar and **DETERMINES** CEN Juncos Solar complied with the May 10 Order.
