RESOLUTION

On May 10, 2023, the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board ("Energy Bureau") issued a Resolution and Order ("May 10 Order") in which it order SUNRUN, INC ("SUNRUN") to within fifteen (15) days, from the notification, submit evidence of the electronic payment of the eight hundred dollars (\$800) for the filing the Operational Report.

On May 24, 2023, SUNRUN, INC. ("SUNRUN") filed a *Motion in Compliance with Resolution and Order notified on May 10, 2023* ("May 24 Motion"), which included evidence of the wire transfer for the payment of the Operational Report Fees.

On June 16, 2023, the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board ("Energy Bureau") issued an Order to Show Cause ("June 16 Order") in which it order SUNRUN to, within fifteen (5) days, from the notification date, (i) present evidence of the payment fee of eight hundred dollars (\$800) for the annual filing of the Operational Report; (ii) show cause why the Energy Bureau should not impose an administrative fine of five hundred dollars (\$500) for its failure to comply with Act 57- 2014¹ and Regulation 8701².

On June 19, 2023, SUNRUN filed a document titled *Showing of Cause in Compliance with Order to Show Cause notified on June 16, 2023* ("June 19 Motion").


The Energy Bureau inadvertently did not consider the May 24 Motion in its June 16 Order. Upon the review of the May 24 Motion and June 19 Motion, the Energy Bureau **ACKNOWLEDGES** the timely evidence presented by SUNRUN since the May 24 Motion and **DETERMINES** it complies with the May 10 Order.
