SUBJECT: Motion in Compliance with Resolution and Order of July 10, 2023

MOTION IN COMPLIANCE WITH RESOLUTION AND ORDER OF JULY 10, 2023 TO THE HONORABLE PUERTO RICO ENERGY BUREAU:

COME NOW LUMA Energy, LLC ("ManagementCo"), and **LUMA Energy Servco, LLC** ("ServCo") (jointly referred to as the "Operator" or "LUMA"), through the undersigned counsel, and respectfully state and request the following:

1. On March 26, 2021, this Puerto Rico Energy Bureau ("Energy Bureau") issued a Resolution and Order in the instant proceeding (the "March 26th Order"), ordering —in pertinent part— that the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority ("PREPA") submit to the Energy Bureau the specific projects to be funded with Federal Emergency Management Agency ("FEMA") funds or any other federal funds at least thirty (30) calendar days prior to submitting these projects to the Puerto Rico Central Office for Recovery, Reconstruction and Resiliency ("COR3"), FEMA or any other federal agency. *See* March 26th Order on pages 18-19. This Energy Bureau thereafter determined that this directive applied to both PREPA and LUMA. *See* Resolution and Order of August 20, 2021 ("August 20th Order") on page 3.

2. On June 28, 2023, LUMA filed an *Informative Motion on Proposal Under Program* 40101(c): Grid Resiliency Grants of the U.S. Department of Energy ("June 28th Motion"). LUMA included its proposal of the Underground Transmission Hardening for Enhanced Resilience project and requested the Energy Bureau to take notice of its plans to submit the aforementioned proposal under Program 40101(c) of the U.S. Department of Energy. Further, LUMA included a project budget breakdown by role, assigning a portion to LUMA's Portion Cost-Share.

3. On July 10, 2023, the Energy Bureau entered a Resolution and Order ("July 10th Order") directing LUMA to provide, within the next five (5) days, the following information:

- submit to the Energy Bureau the sources for the LUMA Portion Cost-Share
 as described in Table 1 of the Resolution and Order,
- (ii) explain if such a budget is included as part of the FY 24 Budget, and
- (iii) explain how foresees that such a budget could be allocated for FY25, FY26,FY27, and FY28.

4. In compliance with the July 10th Order, LUMA hereby submits as Exhibit 1 to this Motion its responses to the requests for information issued by the Energy Bureau.

WHEREFORE, LUMA respectfully requests that the Energy Bureau **take notice** of the aforementioned, and **deem** LUMA complied with the July 10th Order.

- III. Explain how LUMA foresees that such budget could be allocated for FY25, FY26, FY27, and FY28

RESPONSES

- I. The LUMA portion Cost-Share referred to in Table 1 of LUMA's proposal represents the costshare that is responsibility of the Government of Puerto Rico for Department of Energy grants, similar to the Government of Puerto Rico's cost-share responsibility when other sources of federal funding are used. LUMA is working closely with the Government of Puerto Rico to determine availability of funding to be used to cover the respective cost-share if grants are awarded.
- II. Considering grants had not yet been awarded when the FY24 budget was developed, the project's budget was not included within the FY24 Budget proposal.
- III. Below is an initial estimate of how the funds could be allocated for FY24-FY28, dependent on receiving the grant, and the ensuing determinations by the Department of Energy.
