**SUBJECT:** Motion to Submit Progress Report on DDEC Study in compliance with Resolution and Order of August 11, 2023, and request for Change in Reporting Frequency.

**RESOLUTION AND ORDER**

On August 11, 2023, the Energy Bureau issued a Resolution and Order ("August 11 Order") in which among other things the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board ("Energy Bureau") accepted the request made by LUMA Energy ServCo, LLC ("LUMA") regarding the update<sup>1</sup> of a study being prepared by the Department of Economic Development and Commerce ("DDEC", by its Spanish acronym) on the EV load and charging infrastructure buildout analysis ("DDEC Study") after the completion of the DDEC Study. The Energy Bureau also required LUMA to inform the Energy Bureau every two (2) weeks, commencing on August 31, 2023 of the progress of the DDEC Study.<sup>2</sup>

On August 31, 2023, LUMA, filed before the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board ("Energy Bureau") a document titled *Motion to Submit Progress Report on DDEC Study in Compliance with Resolution and Order of August 11, 2023, and Request for Change in Reporting Frequency* ("Request"). As Exhibit I of the Request, Luma included a report on the progress of the DDEC Study to date. Through the Request, LUMA proposes changes in the schedule for the submittal of the required progress reports on DDEC study. According to LUMA, reducing the frequency of the reports will result in more efficiencies in the time and efforts required to prepare the progress reports, as well as more meaningful reports. LUMA suggested instead two interim reports (*i.e.*, one at kick-off and one at close out) and the final report with the study.

LUMA requested the Energy Bureau to take notice of the aforementioned, consider LUMA in compliance with the Energy Bureau order of August 11, 2023 regarding the submittal of the progress report and grant the modification of the progress report submittal frequency.

Upon reviewing LUMA's arguments, the Energy Bureau **TAKES NOTICE** of the filing of progress report, **DEEMS** LUMA in compliance with the August 11 Order. The Energy Bureau **MODIFIES** the progress report filing frequency to: (a) one interim report at kick-off, which LUMA **SHALL** file five (5) calendar days from the commencement of the DDEC Study; (b) one interim report at close out, which LUMA **SHALL** file five (5) calendar days from the DDEC Study close out; and (c) a final report, which LUMA **SHALL** file with the Energy Bureau within five (5) days from the completion of the DDEC Study and accompany the same with a complete and exact copy of the DDEC Study. Note that the interim reports **SHALL** include the projected timeline for the completion of the DDEC study.

Finally, LUMA **SHALL** complete the update on the EV load and charging infrastructure buildout analysis within forty-five (45) days from the completion of the DDEC Study. Notwithstanding the foregoing, LUMA **SHALL**, as it proposed<sup>3</sup>, provide updates to the Energy Bureau on significant changes on the progress of the DDEC study outside of the foregoing reporting schedule.

Be it notified and published.
