SUBJECT: Motion in Compliance with Order regarding "Restricted Parties" provision.

RESOLUTION AND ORDER

On July 18, 2023, Quanta Services Solutions PR, LLC d/b/a Quanta Services Puerto Rico ("Quanta PR"), an affiliate of Quanta Service Inc., ("Quanta"), filed a request with Accion Group, the Puerto Rico Energy Bureau of the Public Service Regulatory Board ("Energy Bureau") Independent Coordinator ("PREB-IC") for Tranches 2-6 of the renewable energy procurement process ("Request"). In the Request Quanta asked the PREB-IC to consider revising the Restricted Parties list in the RFPs for the procurement of renewable energy under Tranches 1-6 to allow Quanta and similarly restricted companies to participate as contractors, subcontractors, suppliers, and vendors in the development, design, engineering, procurement, construction, supply, installation, commissioning, testing or maintenance of the renewable energy projects. Quanta stated that it is not requesting that it or any of its companies or similarly situated service providers be allowed to participate in such projects as a Proponent or Resource Provider or to otherwise own or operate generation energy resources.

On September 1, 2023, the Energy Bureau issued a Resolution and Order requesting the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority ("PREPA") to state its position regarding the Request.


On September 11, 2023, PREPA filed a document titled *Motion in Compliance with Order Regarding Quanta Services Inc., Request for Revision to the Provision Regarding "Restricted Parties" in the RFPs for Tranches 1-6* ("September 11 Motion"). In the September 11 Motion, PREPA states that Quanta should not be removed from the Restricted Parties list for the renewable energy tranches.¹

The Energy Bureau understands that limiting the participation of certain entities or individuals during the RFP process is an appropriate mechanism or measure to manage potential conflicts of interest. The Energy Bureau **CLARIFIES**, however, that parties included in the Restricted Parties List are restricted from being part of the team used by a proponent to develop and present a proposal to an RFP process.




