## MOTION SUBMITTING LUMA'S DECEMBER 2023 UPDATE TO PREPA-LUMA 90-DAY PLAN FOR T&D PROJECTS

#### TO THE PUERTO RICO ENERGY BUREAU:

COME NOW LUMA Energy, LLC ("ManagementCo")<sup>1</sup>, and LUMA Energy ServCo, LLC ("ServCo")<sup>2</sup>, (jointly referred to as "LUMA"), through the undersigned legal counsel and respectfully submits the following:

1. Pursuant to the continued reporting requirements set forth in this Puerto Rico Energy Bureau's ("Energy Bureau") Resolution and Order of March 26, 2021,<sup>3</sup> and in accordance with LUMA's Motion of July 15, 2021,<sup>4</sup> and PREPA's and LUMA's Motion of September 21, 2021<sup>5</sup>, LUMA hereby submits, as *Exhibit 1* to this Motion, LUMA's December 2023 update to the

PREPA-LUMA 90-Day Plan pertaining to the transmission and distribution system projects ("T&D Projects") updating the status of T&D Projects and providing a summary of key next steps for the upcoming 90 days ("December 2023 Update to PREPA-LUMA 90-Day Plan").

2. In addition, as *Exhibit 2* to this Motion, LUMA submits a redline version that compares the update to the PREPA-LUMA 90-Day Plan filed with this Energy Bureau on September 14, 2023 (*see* Exhibit 1 of *Motion Submitting September 2023 Update to PREPA-LUMA 90-Day Plan for T&D Projects* filed by LUMA on that date) with the December 2023 Update to PREPA-LUMA 90-Day Plan being submitted today.

WHEREFORE, LUMA respectfully requests that the Energy Bureau take notice of the aforementioned and accept LUMA's December 2023 Update to PREPA-LUMA 90-Day Plan for T&D Projects submitted herein as Exhibit 1 to this Motion in compliance with LUMA's reporting obligations.

### December 2023

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#### I. Introduction

In accordance with the directive received from FEMA to produce a 90-Day Plan, this document captures an overview of the key next steps and progress made on FEMA-funded projects for the Puerto Rico electric transmission and distribution grid.

On June 1, 2021, LUMA assumed overall responsibilities for the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority's (PREPA) Transmission and Distribution (T&D) System as outlined within the Operations and Maintenance Agreement (OMA) between PREPA, P3A, and LUMA. Upon commencement of the Service Period, PREPA refocused its efforts on projects in the Generation and Dams, Hydro, and Irrigation asset categories; while projects in the Transmission, Distribution, Substations, IT/Telecom, Buildings, and other categories (T&D Projects) were transitioned to and are now the responsibility of LUMA.

This 90-Day Plan provides information on various focus areas for LUMA.

#### II. Overview of Focus Areas for the Next 90 Days

The content below summarizes next steps across the following five areas:

- 1. PREPA-LUMA Coordination and Alignment
- 2. Federal Grant Management
- 3. Funding and Reporting
- 4. Environmental and Historic Preservation
- 5. Engineering Management

#### 1. PREPA-LUMA Coordination and Alignment

PREPA and LUMA goals for the next 90 days:

- PREPA and LUMA leadership will participate in regular weekly meetings with the Central Office for Recovery, Reconstruction, and Resiliency (COR3), FEMA, and Genera, to ensure visibility of project progress, the coordination and understanding of common matters, and to identify and resolve risks that involve points of integration between the entities.
- LUMA will continue to coordinate with PREPA and Genera to support successful operations under the T&D OMA.
- LUMA and PREPA will continue to collaborate on the Vieques and Culebra Microgrid Project. LUMA has assumed project lead responsibilities and coordinating the project hand-offs for design, construction, and post-production phases for the appropriate operational



jurisdictions. LUMA is engaged with COR3 and P3A to identify and collaborate on project construction and operational jurisdiction challenges related to the O&M Agreement between LUMA and PREPA.

#### 2. Federal Grant Management

#### LUMA goals for the next 90 days:

- LUMA will continue working with FEMA and COR3 to obtain project obligations for the 142 detailed scopes of work (DSOWs) that have been submitted but are not yet obligated.
- LUMA will secure obligation for critical projects, including engineering, procurement, and construction (EPC) projects, and the Vegetation Clearing Project.
- LUMA will develop and submit 52 DSOWs for grid automation to align with an execution strategy.
- LUMA will seek obligation for additional long-lead materials.

#### During the last 90-day period, LUMA completed the following:

- LUMA submitted 43 DSOWs to FEMA for approval, representing \$1.2 billion in capital investments.
- LUMA aligned on approach to scope changes of one-year hazard mitigation activities. Awaiting letter and guidance on path forward from COR3 and FEMA.

#### 3. Funding and Reporting

#### LUMA goals for the next 90 days:

- LUMA expects to submit \$40 million in requests for reimbursements (RFRs) during the next quarter.
- LUMA will continue implementation of a time reporting and technology project to automate request for reimbursement (RFR) process related to federally funded projects. The goal is to accelerate submissions to COR3 while ensuring federal compliance.
- LUMA will continue to redesign processes to provide the necessary tools to determine the federal funding eligibility.

#### During the last 90-day period, LUMA completed the following:

 LUMA has submitted \$129 million in requests for reimbursements RFRs to date. Another \$14 million is expected to be submitted by the end of December 2023.



 LUMA submitted the Q1 FY2024 Federal Funding Report to the PREB highlighting LUMA's progress in executing activities related to federally funded T&D projects.

Key milestones during the first quarter included:

- Seventeen FEMA-obligated T&D projects started construction.
- Sixty-seven DSOWs submitted to COR3 and FEMA, including EPC projects to deploy critical new substations.
- Forty initial scopes of work (ISOWs) were submitted to FEMA for FAASt numbers.
- Forty-one T&D projects received FEMA FAASt numbers, including grid automation and vegetation clearing projects.

#### 4. Environmental and Historic Preservation

#### LUMA goals for the next 90 days:

- LUMA will work with FEMA and COR3 to establish a programmatic approach to boring plan access road reviews and environmental compliance.
- LUMA will work with FEMA and COR3 on the phase 1 and levels 1 and 2 archeological review requirements and align with project scopes and areas of potential effect (APE).
- LUMA will continue with biweekly FEMA/EHP meetings and consultations to support project development and execution.
- LUMA will continue environmental field inspections on construction projects with FEMA-approved DSOWs. The inspections include assessment of:
  - Adherence to requirements for equipment use, vegetation clearing, waste handling and other activities
  - Employee training in environmental awareness
  - Measures being taken to protect endangered and protected species
  - Ground disturbance management practices
  - o Compliance with archeological and/or historic site considerations
  - Proper execution of work near bodies of water (buffer zones and/or permits)
  - Waste management (e.g., staging, segregation, transportation) as well as the final facility (landfill, recycling, or reuse)
- LUMA will review the compliance inspection forms and provide training to employees and contractor to ensure environmental compliance.



- LUMA will continue archaeological desktop reviews with external contractors towards the development of DSOWs.
- LUMA will continue with the development of process for work in areas that require managing lead-containing materials.
- LUMA will review the following health, safety, and environmental policies: asbestos (0724); spill response (0310); waste management (0315); and acquisition and divestiture environmental requirements for alignment with EHP process (0330).

#### During the last 90-day period, LUMA completed the following:

- LUMA EHP team completed an internal environmental assessment for vegetation clearance. This activity supported the identification of environmentally sensitive and nonsensitive areas toward developing vegetation DSOW development, obligation, and priority project execution.
- LUMA, COR3, and FEMA continue to develop effective EHP processes for environmental compliance in regard to project development, formulation and obligation for EPC projects.
- LUMA will continue to engage with the Instituto de Cultura Puertorriqueña (ICP) to expedite the required archaeological studies for all projects.
   Continued coordination between LUMA and ICP takes place on a projectby-project basis for the phase 1 archeological reviews.
- LUMA completed the installation of containers to store used transformers in the technical offices of Bayamon, Guayama, Caguas, and Aguadilla in compliance with the Clean Water Act (CWA) and the spill prevention program.

#### 5. Engineering Management

#### LUMA goals for next 90 days:

- LUMA will complete an additional six distribution area plans to identify rebuild priorities and mitigation solutions for contingency issues and determine sectionalization and segmentation needs (e.g., installation of grid automation) to enhance reliability.
- LUMA will submit ISOWs for an additional 22 transmission line rebuild projects and commence the A&E assignment of those projects.
- LUMA will continue to make progress on the 38 kV transmission lines area plans to improve transmission reliability. The work includes mitigation for N-1 contingency violations, activation of a segmentation and sectionalization strategy, and ensuring that customers will have load transfer capability. This



work will continue during the next 90 days but will not be completed during that period.

- LUMA is continuing work on improving system models and ensuring that computer-based models match the physical condition of the grid. This will ensure proper analysis can be performed to support the area planning effort, grid automation device placements, feeder solar PV hosting capacity, and distribution feeder rebuilds.
  - Additionally, LUMA is performing distribution feeder verification in the field to refine the mapping data. The data collected will include, but are not limited to, conductor sizes, transformer sizes, checking for connectivity, locating missing meters, tie points, grid automation devices, regulators, and capacitor banks.
- LUMA will continue engineering on all projects with FEMA-approved DSOWs.
- LUMA will submit DSOWs for critical projects including transmission lines and distribution projects.
- LUMA will award contract(s) under A&E RFP for engineering studies.

#### During the last 90-day period, LUMA completed the following:

- LUMA completed the planning technical studies and functional specifications on 22 transmission lines for long-term transmission reliability solutions.
- LUMA conducted preliminary engineering, including system planning review, standards review, and the development of preliminary design packages and class 3 estimates, to support the submission of 43 DSOWs to FEMA for approval, representing \$1.2 billion in capital investments.
- LUMA continued preliminary engineering design work with existing A&E firms towards the development of DSOWs.
- LUMA continued engineering on all projects with FEMA-approved DSOWs.
- LUMA submitted DSOWs for critical projects including vegetation clearing, transmission lines, and distribution feeder rebuild projects.

#### III. LUMA Estimated Schedule for DSOW Submission

Over the next 90 days, LUMA will be focused on preparing DSOWs and cost estimates for T&D projects. The tables below show the existing set of projects, by asset category, along with the estimated timing for DSOWs submittals to COR3 and FEMA.

The estimation of project submission timing noted below is based on the best information available to LUMA at the time of this plan update. LUMA is focused on meeting or exceeding the project submission estimates listed in the table below.



Note: Self-performed work includes work performed by Luma internal labor and Quanta contractors. Self-performed work is designated as contracted work (CW), mostly contracted work (MCW), or mostly self-performed work (MSPW).

- **Mostly contracted work (MCW**) = more than 65% of the work is procured/contracted (excluding management and oversight).
- Mostly self-performed work (MSPW) = more than 65% of the work is performed by LUMA (excluding management and oversight).
- A mixture of contracted work and LUMA self-performed work (CW/SPW) = between 50/50% and 65/35% (excluding management and oversight).

#### **Substations**

\*Construction start dates assume timely FEMA obligation of the relevant DSOWs and approval of the underlying contracts by the Financial Oversight and Management Board and P3A, if required. LUMA will be ready to proceed with construction or as soon thereafter as necessary supplies are available.

- Equipment replacements
- Civil and low-voltage work to support projects

We will continue to refine this section in collaboration with P3A as we move forward.







# **December** 2023

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#### I. Introduction

In accordance with the directive received from FEMA to produce a 90-Day Plan, this document captures an overview of the key next steps and progress made on FEMA-funded projects for the Puerto Rico electric transmission and distribution grid.

On June 1, 2021, LUMA assumed overall responsibilities for the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority's (PREPA) Transmission and Distribution (T&D) System as outlined within the Operations and Maintenance Agreement (OMA) between PREPA, P3A, and LUMA. Upon commencement of the Service Period, PREPA refocused its efforts on projects in the Generation and Dams, Hydro, and Irrigation asset categories; while projects in the Transmission, Distribution, Substations, IT/Telecom, Buildings, and other categories (T&D Projects) were transitioned to and are now the responsibility of LUMA.

This 90-Day Plan provides information on various focus areas for LUMA.

### II. Overview of Focus Areas for the Next 90 Days

The content below summarizes next steps across the following five areas:

- 1. PREPA-LUMA Coordination and Alignment
- 2. Federal Grant Management
- 3. Funding and Reporting
- 4. Environmental and Historic Preservation
- 5. Engineering Management

### 1. PREPA-LUMA Coordination and Alignment

PREPA and LUMA goals for the next 90 days:

- PREPA and LUMA leadership will participate in regular weekly meetings with the Central Office for Recovery, Reconstruction, and Resiliency (COR3)-&), FEMA, and Genera, to ensure visibility-of progress of project progress, the coordination and understanding of common matters, and to identify and resolve risks that involve points of integration between the two entities.
- LUMA will continue to coordinate with PREPA and Genera to support successful operations under the T&D OMA.
- LUMA and PREPA will continue to collaborate on the Vieques and Culebra Microgrid Project. LUMA is assuminghas assumed project lead responsibilities and coordinating the project hand-offs for design,



- construction, and post-production phases for the appropriate operational jurisdictions. LUMA is engaged with COR3 and P3A to identify and collaborate on project construction and operational jurisdiction challenges related to the O&M Agreement between LUMA and PREPA.
- LUMA continues to collaborate directly with PREPA and Genera at the leadership, working group, and project levels as Genera assumes their role as Generation Operator. This transition will evolve over the next 90 days.

### 2. Federal Grant Management

#### LUMA goals for the next 90 days:

- LUMA will continue working with COR3 and FEMA and COR3 to obtain
  project obligations for the 106142 detailed statementsscopes of work
  (DSOWs) submitted to date that have been submitted but are not yet to be
  obligated.
- LUMA will continue advancing work on Section 428secure obligation for critical projects-with, including engineering, procurement, and construction (EPC) projects, and the goal of finalizing Vegetation Clearing Project.
- <u>LUMA will develop and submit 52</u> DSOWs for submission to COR3 and FEMA. This effort includes Sections 404 and 406 of the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP) and Environmental and Historic Preservation (EHP) work. LUMA expects to submit grid automation to align with an execution strategy.
- LUMA will seek obligation for additional long-lead materials.
- <u>During DSOWs within the nextlast 90-day period as per target schedule below., LUMA completed the following:</u>
  - LUMA will continue refining Section 406 Hazard Mitigation Grant Program strategies for all asset classes including distribution, transmission, substation, and IT/OT. LUMA will continue to conduct discussions with COR3 and FEMA for feedback and alignment.
  - LUMA will continue providing the reconciliation costs to support submissions for project formulation.

#### During the last 90-day period, LUMA completed the following:

 Submitted 71<u>LUMA submitted 43</u> DSOWs to FEMA for approval, representing \$4.61.2 billion in capital investments.



- Received an amended obligation for an additional \$600 million to support Architecture and Engineering (A&E) resources.
- Obtained FEMA authorization and project obligations on six DSOWs representing \$99.6 million in capital investments.
- LUMA aligned on approach to scope changes of one-year hazard mitigation activities. Awaiting letter and guidance on path forward from COR3 and FEMA.

### 3. Funding and Reporting

#### LUMA goals for the next 90 days:

- LUMA will continue expects to track project actual costs in accordance with FEMA, HUD, and COR3 standards to support financial reporting requirements for federally funded projects.
- LUMA will continue executing self-performing work (see section IV in this plan).submit \$40

#### During the last 90-day period, LUMA completed the following:

- LUMA submitted \$81 million in requests for reimbursements (RFRs) to COR3 to date. Another \$26 million is expected to be submitted during the next 90-day periodquarter.
- LUMA continued the will continue implementation of a time reporting and technology project to automate request for reimbursement (RFR) process related to federally funded projects. The goal is to accelerate submissions to COR3 while ensuring federal compliance.
- LUMA incorporated additional best practices from RFRs submitted to date.
  They have aided in prioritizing projects, optimizing preparation time, and
  improving the overall quality of documentation for RFR submissions
  moving forward. Best practices include task standardization for A&E and
  Category Z, data integrity validity automation, metrics for requests for
  information, and RFI mitigating measures.
- LUMA engaged with our grid recovery partners on additional federal funding opportunities to include:
  - U.S. Department of Energy electrical system improvement grants
  - Puerto Rico Department of Housing's Community Development Block Grant – Disaster Recovery (PRDOH CDBG-DR) Program for hazard mitigation via the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD)
- LUMA will continue to redesign processes to provide the necessary tools to determine the federal funding eligibility.



- LUMA has submitted \$129 million in requests for reimbursements RFRs to date. Another \$14 million is expected to be submitted by the end of December 2023.
- LUMA submitted the Q1 FY2024 Federal Funding Report to the PREB highlighting LUMA's progress in executing activities related to federally funded T&D projects.

Key milestones during the first quarter included:

- Seventeen FEMA-obligated T&D projects started construction.
- Sixty-seven DSOWs submitted to COR3 and FEMA, including EPC projects to deploy critical new substations.
- Forty initial scopes of work (ISOWs) were submitted to FEMA for FAASt numbers.
- Forty-one T&D projects received FEMA FAASt numbers, including grid automation and vegetation clearing projects.

#### 4. Environmental and Historic Preservation

#### LUMA goals for the next 90 days:

- LUMA will work with FEMA and COR3 to establish a programmatic approach to boring plan access road reviews and environmental compliance.
- LUMA will work with FEMA and COR3 on the phase 1 and levels 1 and 2 archeological review requirements and align with project scopes and areas of potential effect (APE).
- LUMA will continue with <u>biweekly</u> FEMA/<u>EHP</u> meetings and consultations to support project development and execution.
- <u>LUMA will outline ancontinue</u> environmental compliance strategy<u>field</u> inspections on construction projects with FEMA-approved DSOWs. The inspections include assessment of:
  - Adherence to requirements for equipment use, vegetation clearanceclearing, waste handling and other activities
  - <u>Employee training</u> in accordance with the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service. environmental awareness
  - Measures being taken to protect endangered and protected species
  - Ground disturbance management practices
  - Compliance with archeological and/or historic site considerations



- Proper execution of work near bodies of water (buffer zones and/or permits)
- Waste management (e.g., staging, segregation, transportation) as well as the final facility (landfill, recycling, or reuse)
- LUMA will review the compliance inspection forms and provide training to employees and contractor to ensure environmental compliance.
- LUMA will continue archaeological desktop reviews with external contractors towards the development of DSOWs.
- LUMA will continue with the development of process for work in areas that require managing lead-containing materials.
- LUMA will review the following health, safety, and environmental policies: asbestos (0724); spill response (0310); waste management (0315); and acquisition and divestiture environmental requirements for alignment with EHP process (0330).\_\_\_\_\_

- LUMA will continue with the development of process for work in areas that require managing lead containing materials.
- LUMA will outline EHP team completed an internal environmental compliance strategy for assessment for vegetation clearance. This activity supported the identification of environmentally sensitive and nonsensitive areas toward developing vegetation DSOW development, obligation, and priority project execution.
- <u>LUMA, COR3, and FEMA continue to develop</u> effective EHP
   <del>process</del>processes for environmental compliance in regard to project
   <u>development, formulation and obligation</u> for engineering, procurement,
   <del>and construction (EPC)</del> projects.
- To the extent possible, LUMA will expedite the process continue to engage with the Instituto de Cultura Puertorriqueña (ICP) to complete expedite the required archaeological studies for transmission lines. all projects.
   Continued coordination between LUMA and ICP takes place on a project-by-project basis for the phase 1 archeological reviews.
- LUMA <u>will complete completed the</u> installation of containers to store used transformers in the technical offices of Bayamon, Guayama, Caguas, and Aguadilla in compliance with the Clean Water Act (CWA) and the spill prevention program.
- LUMA will begin the underground injection control compliance plan with Capital Programs and substations.



- LUMA continued to review initial FEMA Record of Environmental Considerations (RECs) for approved projects for integration into project scopes.
- LUMA continued to support preconstruction and construction inspection visits, along with implementing mitigation measures required by FEMA EHP and other agencies to meet environmental conditions. We also provided supporting documents for a class-three estimate.
- LUMA continued notifying and requesting endorsements from government agencies for projects obligated by FEMA.
- LUMA developed a template for underground injection control system closures.
- LUMA implemented the first phase of the corporate recycling program.
- LUMA reviewed these health, safety, and environmental policies: vegetation management (0320); wildlife, avian, and historical resources protection (0335); working near waterbodies (0325); and stormwater and erosion control (0340).

### 5. Engineering Management

#### LUMA goals for next 90 days:

- LUMA will continue preliminary engineering design work with existing A&E firms towards the development of DSOWs.
- LUMA will continue engineering and construction on all projects with FEMAapproved DSOWs.
- LUMA will submit DSOWs for critical projects including vegetation clearing, transmission lines, and LUMA will complete an additional six distribution feeder rebuild projects.
- We will award contract(s) under planning studies RFP for engineering studies including area planning, distribution automation, distribution evaluations and studies, substation analysis and others.
- LUMA will continue to evaluate and prioritize existing FEMA projects against the needs and constraints of the electrical system and available contractor capacities to optimize the execution strategies.
- <u>LUMA will continue work on the area plan analysisplans</u> to identify <u>rebuild</u> <u>priorities and mitigation solutions for</u> contingency issues and <u>provide backup</u> <u>analysis to determine sectionalization and segmentation needs (e.g., installation of <u>distributiongrid</u> automation) to enhance reliability.\_\_
  </u>



- LUMA will submit ISOWs for an additional 22 transmission line rebuild projects and commence the A&E assignment of those projects.
- LUMA will continue to make progress on the 38 kV transmission lines area plans to improve transmission reliability. The work includes mitigation for N-1 contingency violations, activation of a segmentation and sectionalization strategy, and ensuring that customers will have load transfer capability. This work will continue during the next 90 days but will not be completed during that period.
- LUMA is workingcontinuing work on improving system models and performing distribution feeder verification.ensuring that computer-based models match the physical condition of the grid. This will ensure proper analysis can be performed based on accurate to support the area planning effort, grid automation device placements, feeder solar PV hosting capacity, and distribution feeder rebuilds.
  - Additionally, LUMA is performing distribution feeder verification in the field to refine the mapping data. The models data collected will include, but are not limited to, conductor sizes, transformer sizes, checking for connectivity, locating missing meters, tie points, distribution grid automation devices, regulators, and capacitor banks.\_\_\_\_\_
- <u>LUMA is reviewing the 38 kV transmission lines and performing area plans to improve reliability. The work includes mitigation for N-1 contingency violations and ensuring that customers will have load transfer capability. This work will occur during the next 90 days but will not be completed during that period. LUMA will continue engineering on all projects with FEMA-approved DSOWs.</u>
- LUMA will submit DSOWs for critical projects including transmission lines and distribution projects.
- LUMA will award contract(s) under A&E RFP for engineering studies.

- LUMA completed the planning technical studies and functional specifications on five22 transmission lines and four substations for long-term transmission reliability solutions.
- LUMA conducted preliminary engineering, including system planning review, standards review, and the development of preliminary design packages and class 3 estimates, to support the submission of 7143 DSOWs to FEMA for approval, representing \$4.61.2 billion dollars of workin capital investments.



- LUMA continued preliminary engineering design work with existing A&E firms towards the development of DSOWs.
- LUMA continued engineering on all projects with FEMA-approved DSOWs.
- LUMA submitted DSOWs for critical projects including vegetation clearing, transmission lines, and distribution feeder rebuild projects.

#### III. LUMA Estimated Schedule for DSOW Submission

Over the next 90 days, LUMA will be focused on preparing DSOWs and cost estimates for T&D projects. The tables below show the existing set of projects, by asset category, along with the estimated timing for DSOWs submittals to COR3 and FEMA.

The estimation of project submission timing noted below is based on the best information available to LUMA at the time of this plan update. LUMA is focused on meeting or exceeding the project submission estimates listed in the table below.

Note: Self-performed work includes work performed by Luma internal labor and Quanta contractors. Self-performed work is designated as contracted work (CW), mostly contracted work (MCW), or mostly self-performed work (MSPW).

- **Mostly contracted work (MCW**) = more than 65% of the work is procured/contracted (excluding management and oversight).
- **Mostly self-performed work (MSPW)** = more than 65% of the work is performed by LUMA (excluding management and oversight).
- A mixture of contracted work and LUMA self-performed work (CW/SPW) = between 50/50% and 65/35% (excluding management and oversight).

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
