SUBJECT: Motion in compliance with
Resolution and Order of November 27,
2023, and request for confidential
treatment of information.

RESOLUTION

On November 27, 2023, the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board ("Energy Bureau") issued an Resolution and Order ("November 27 Order"), in which it ordered SUNE W-PR1, LLC ("SUNE W-PR1") to, within five (5) days, from the notification date, file a certification or any other evidence to demonstrate its Fiscal Year 2022 Financial Statements were compiled by a Certified Public Accountant (CPA) authorized to practice such profession in Puerto Rico, or in any jurisdiction of the United States of America, as required by Section 4.02(E) of Regulation 8701¹.

On December 4, 2023, SUNE W-PR1 filed a document titled *Motion in Compliance with Resolution and Order dated November 27, 2023* ("December 4 Motion"), which included a copy of the Registration Certificate of their Certified Public Accountant.

In the December 4 Motion, SUNE W-PR1 requested confidential treatment to the information in the motion and its attachments ("December 4 Request"). SUNE W-PR1 argues that the information for which they request protection is of confidential nature, therefore has sensitive personal details that are rarely disclosed publicly to protect the privacy and security of the registered professional².

Act No. 57-2014³ establishes that any person having the obligation to submit information to the Energy Bureau, may request that any information deemed privileged or confidential be treated in such fashion⁴. Specifically, Act 57-2014 requires from the Energy Bureau to treat as confidential the information submitted provided that "after the appropriate evaluation, believes such information should be protected"⁵. In such case, "the Energy Bureau shall grant such protection in a manner that least affects the public interest, transparency, and the rights of the parties involved in the administrative procedure in which the allegedly confidential documents are submitted⁶.

Upon a thorough examination of the arguments brought forth by SUNE W-PR1, the Energy Bureau **GRANTS** confidential designation and treatment to the Confidential Documents, under Article 6.15 of Act 57-2014 and Section 1.15 of Regulation 8701.

The Energy Bureau **ACKNOWLEDGES** the evidence presented by SUNE W-PR1 and **DETERMINES** SUNE W-PR1 complied with the November 27 Order.


