SUBJECT: Resolution and Order about a *Motion Requesting Continuance of Compliance Hearing Scheduled for January 18, 2024.*

RESOLUTION AND ORDER

On October 3, 2023, the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board ("Energy Bureau") issued a Resolution and Order ("October 3 Order") in which, among others, it instructed LUMA¹ to file the Interconnections Progress Report for the fourth quarter of Fiscal Year 2023 on January 15, 2024. The October 3 Order also scheduled the Compliance Hearings for each quarter to discuss the quarterly reports. The next compliance hearing has been scheduled for January 18, 2024, at 10:00 a.m.²

On December 20, 2023, LUMA filed a document titled *Motion Requesting Continuance of Compliance Hearing Scheduled for January 18, 2024*. ("December 20 Request"), in which LUMA respectfully requests that the Energy Bureau continue the Compliance Hearing scheduled for January 18, 2024. LUMA informs the Energy Bureau that they have designated Mr. Charles Tweten as one of the key witnesses for the Compliance Hearing and that Mr. Tweten is unavailable to attend the scheduled January 18, 2024, Compliance Hearing due to previous engagements. The December 20 Request indicates that Mr. Tweten is available to attend the Compliance Hearing on January 23 or 24, 2024. As such, LUMA requests that the Compliance Hearing be rescheduled on any of the proposed dates.³

Upon review, the Energy Bureau **GRANTS** LUMA continuance of the Compliance Hearing previously scheduled for January 18, 2024, and therefore reschedules the hybrid Compliance Hearing for **January 24, 2024, 10 a.m.** The hybrid Technical Conference will be held in person⁴ and on the *Microsoft Teams* platform in order to facilitate participation by the Energy Bureau's experts and LUMA's representatives that are not located in Puerto Rico. All persons that are not in Puerto Rico for the date of this hearing, must request access to participate virtually on or before 2:00 p.m. of the day before the Compliance Hearing by (i) sending an email to secretaria@jrsp.pr.gov, or (ii) contacting the Energy Bureau's Clerk at (787) 523-6262.

The Compliance Hearing shall be streamed live in both English and Spanish through the Energy Bureau's YouTube channel which shall be available to the public.

The remaining requirements established in the October 3 Order remain unaltered.
