**RENEWED MOTION FOR BRIEF EXTENSION OF TIME TO COMPLY WITH  
THE DECEMBER 8<sup>TH</sup> RESOLUTION**

**TO THE HONORABLE ENERGY BUREAU:**

**COMES NOW** the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority ("PREPA") through its undersigned legal representation and, very respectfully, informs and requests as follows:

1. On December 8<sup>th</sup>, 2023, the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board ("Energy Bureau") issued a *Resolution and Order* ("December 8<sup>th</sup> Order") whereby it ordered PREPA, *inter alia*, to prepare and submit for the Energy Bureau's review: (a) a Detailed Plan with action items, expected results, responsible party(ies), and due dates needed to achieve the reduced headcount footprint and labor expenses, starting on July 1, 2024, to get the HoldCo Organization in line with both staffing levels and business operations that correctly correspond to its substantially downsized mandated and associated approved budgets as it was originally approved in the June 25 Resolution ("*Detailed Plan*"); and (b) a Monthly Status Update on the status of the

defined actions and any added corrective actions needed to take to achieve the desired results by July 1, 2024 (“*Monthly Status Update*”).

2. On February 6<sup>th</sup>, 2024, PREPA filed a *Motion for Extension of Time to Comply with December 8<sup>th</sup> Resolution* (“*Motion*”) where it requested an extension of thirty (30) days to comply with the December 8<sup>th</sup> Order.

3. On February 29<sup>th</sup>, 2024, the Energy Bureau granted the *Motion* and allowed PREPA until March 7<sup>th</sup>, 2024, to comply with the December 8<sup>th</sup> Order.

4. Despite its diligent efforts, PREPA has been unable to complete the requested *Detailed Plan* and the *Monthly Status Update*. While the corresponding drafts are in advanced stages, PREPA's Human Resources Department, Finance Department and other departments are still reviewing relevant data to reach final determinations on the matter at hand and present accurate information to the Energy Bureau.

5. In light of the foregoing, PREPA hereby, respectfully requests a brief extension of fifteen (15) days, **until March 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2024**, to comply with the December 8<sup>th</sup> Resolution.

**WHEREFORE**, PREPA respectfully requests the Energy Bureau to **GRANT** the requested extension of **fifteen (15) days, until March 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2024**, to comply with the December 8<sup>th</sup> Resolution.
