SUBJECT: Resolution and Order pertaining to the *Motion Submitting Fourth Report on Demobilization of FEMA Generation and Request to Release LUMA from the Requirement to File Bi-Weekly Demobilization Reports.*

RESOLUTION AND ORDER

On November 14, 2023, the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board ("Energy Bureau") issued a Resolution and Order ("November 14 Order") through which, among others, in its pertinent part, releases LUMA¹ from filing additional bi-weekly reports to the Stabilization Plan. The Energy Bureau nonetheless required LUMA to inform of "any work conducting to the decommission of the 350MW emergency generation resources ("Temporary Units") which shall trigger LUMA to resume the Bi-Weekly reporting requirement."²

On February 15, 2024, LUMA filed a document titled *Motion Submitting Fourth Report on Demobilization of FEMA Generation and Request to Release LUMA from the Requirement to File Bi-Weekly Demobilization Reports* ("February 15 Request"), in which LUMA understands that PREPA³, COR3⁴ and FEMA⁵ are working to complete the acquisition of the Temporary Units. This means that there are no immediate plans to decommission the Temporary Units. Given that currently, the Temporary Unites will not be decommissioned, LUMA submits that it does not have information on demobilization or decommissioning of the Temporary Units to submit to the Energy Bureau. In fact, LUMA is not currently involved in demobilization efforts. To wit, in the past two weeks, no meetings have taken place to discuss decommissioning the Temporary Units. Considering the above, LUMA requests that the Energy Bureau accept the Fourth Demobilization Report submitted as *Exhibit 1* to ("February 15 Request") and release LUMA of further decommissioning reports.⁶

Upon review, the Energy Bureau **RELEASES** LUMA from the requirement to file Bi-Weekly demobilization reports.


