**RESOLUTION**


On March 1, 2024, the company SunEdison Puerto Rico, LLC (“SunEdison”) filed a document titled *Motion to Request Confidential Treatment of 2024 Gross Revenues* (“March 1 Request”) before the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board (“Energy Bureau”), with the following attachment: (i) *Gross Revenue and Financial Statement Report Electrical Power Companies* (Form NEPR-B05).

In the March 1 Request, SunEdison requested that all the information contained in the motion and its attachment be kept confidential alleging that such information is of sensitive nature, is not available to the public, and disclosure of such information would place SunEdison at a competitive disadvantage and cause it economic harm.<sup>1</sup>

Act No. 57-2014<sup>2</sup> establishes that any person having the obligation to submit information to the Energy Bureau, may request that any information deemed privileged or confidential be treated in such fashion.<sup>3</sup> Specifically, Act 57-2014 requires from the Energy Bureau to treat as confidential the information submitted provided that “after the appropriate evaluation, believes such information should be protected”.<sup>4</sup> In such case, “the Energy Bureau shall grant such protection in a manner that least affects the public interest, transparency, and the rights of the parties involved in the administrative procedure in which the allegedly confidential document is submitted”.<sup>5</sup>


The Energy Bureau **TAKES NOTICE** of the information presented by SunEdison in the form NEPR-B05 and upon a thorough examination of the arguments brought forth by SunEdison, the Energy Bureau **GRANTS** confidential designation and treatment to the Confidential Documents, under Article 6.15 of Act 57-2014.
