**JOINT MOTION REQUESTING RESCHEDULING OF APRIL COMPLIANCE
HEARING, ALLOWING STAKEHOLDERS TIME TO REVIEW PROGRESS
REPORT**

TO THE HONORABLE ENERGY BUREAU

The Puerto Rico Solar Energy and Storage Association (SESA), and the Independent Consumer Protection Office (ICPO) respectfully state, submit and request:

1. During the last Compliance Hearing on the Interconnection Progress Report, the various stakeholders had ample opportunity to review the Progress Report in good time before the hearing in order to be prepared and ready to discuss the Report in depth during the day of the hearing, which was very useful and positive.
2. Specifically, the Progress Report for the period from October to December 2023, with its annexes, was shared via email on January 16, 2024 and the Honorable Bureau held the corresponding hearing on Wednesday, January 24, 2024, 8 days later. On previous occasions, the time difference between the submission of the Progress Report and the corresponding hearing had been only two (2) days.
3. SESA and OIPC consider that this good practice of granting reasonable time to all parties to review and understand the Progress Reports before their discussion at a

hearing before the Bureau should be repeated and adopted. We believe establishment of this practice would also be to the benefit of this Honorable Bureau and other stakeholders.

4. For all of the above, our proposal and request to the Honorable Bureau is that all parties be granted at least ten (10) to be able to responsibly review any Progress Report before the corresponding hearing before the Bureau, beginning with the Progress Report to be submitted in April 2024.

WHEREFORE, we respectfully request the Honorable Energy Bureau to consider and grant the request herein.
