RESOLUTION

On March 4, 2024, the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board ("Energy Bureau") issued a Resolution and Order ("March 4 Resolution") through which it established the annual Emergency Response Plan ("ERP") revision interactive process that for the 2024 evaluation cycle includes a Technical Conference originally scheduled for March 28, 2024.

On March 27, 2024, the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority ("PREPA") filed a document titled Motion to Request Continuance of Technical Conference ("March 27 Request"). PREPA requested that the Energy Bureau grant a continuance of the Technical Conference scheduled for April 3, 2024 because PREPA had not received and has not been able to review the Emergency Response Plan ("ERP") from the Independent Power Producers ("IPPs") as ordered by the Energy Bureau through its March 4 Resolution. PREPA requests that the Technical Conference be rescheduled for the last week of April 2024 and that the time for submission of its IPPs' ERPs evaluation before the Energy Bureau be extended until April 15, 2024.2

On March 28, 2024, LUMA³ filed a document titled Motion to Join PREPA's Motion to Request Continuance of Technical Conference ("March 28 Request"). LUMA states that it joins PREPA's March 27 Request to continue the Technical Conference scheduled for April 3, 2024, until the last week of April 2024 which will allow for informal meetings and lead to a more engaging and productive technical conference.4

On April 2, 2024, the Energy Bureau issued a Resolution ("April 2 Resolution"), through which it granted PREPA's and LUMA's requests for continuance, and rescheduled the virtual Technical Conference to April 25, 2024, at 10:00 am.5

The agenda for the Technical Conference is included as **Attachment A** to this Resolution.
