SUBJECT: Motion for Confidential Treatment of 2024 Operational Report and Annexes.

RESOLUTION

On April 1, 2024, CEN JUNCOS SOLAR, LLC (“CEN JUNCOS”) filed a document titled *Motion to Request Confidential Treatment of 2024 Operational Report and Other Remedies* (“April 1 Motion”) before the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board (“Energy Bureau”). As Attachment 1 CEN JUNCOS included the: (i) *Operational Report Electric Power Companies* (Form NEPR-B03), (ii) *2024 Operational Report Annexes* and (iii) *Evidence of the Wire Transfer for the Payment of the Operational Report Fees*.

In the April 1 Motion, CEN JUNCOS requested that all information in the Form NEPR- B03 and annexes be kept confidential alleging that such information is of sensitive nature, is not available to the public, and disclosure of such information would place CEN JUNCOS at a competitive disadvantage and cause it economic harm.¹

On April 9, 2024, CEN JUNCOS filed a document titled *Motion to Amend 2024 Operational Report Annexes and Request Confidential Treatment*. (“April 9 Motion”). In the April 9 Request, CEN JUNCOS included as Attachment 1 its Amended Operational Report Annexes, due to a clerical error in the document submitted on the April 1 Motion. CEN JUNCOS requests the information contained in the Amended Operational Report Annexes be kept confidential, alleging that such information is of a sensitive nature, is not available to the public, and disclosure of such information would place CEN JUNCOS at a competitive disadvantage and cause it economic harm.²

Act No. 57-2014² establishes that any person having the obligation to submit information to the Energy Bureau, may request that any information deemed privileged or confidential be treated in such fashion.³ Specifically, Act 57-2014 requires from the Energy Bureau to treat as confidential the information submitted provided that “after the appropriate evaluation, believes such information should be protected”.³ In such case, “the Energy Bureau shall grant such protection in a manner that least affects the public interest, transparency, and the rights of the parties involved in the administrative procedure in which the allegedly confidential document is submitted”.⁴

The Energy Bureau **TAKES NOTICE** of the information presented by CEN JUNCOS in the form NEPR-B03 and its amended annexes. Upon a thorough examination of the arguments brought forth by CEN JUNCOS, the Energy Bureau **GRANTS** confidential designation and treatment to the Confidential Documents, under Article 6.15 of Act 57-2014.
