**RESOLUTION AND ORDER**

The Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board (the "Energy Bureau") is evaluating the annual fees applicable to Sunrun, Inc. ("Sunrun") as established in Section 4.02 of Regulation 8701.<sup>1</sup>

After evaluating the submitted information<sup>2</sup> the Energy Bureau **ORDERS** Sunrun to respond **no later than five (5) days of the notification of this Resolution and Order** to the *Request for Information*, as outlined in **Attachment A** to this Resolution and Order. To the extent deemed advisable, members of the Energy Bureau staff and its consultants may conduct informal meetings with Sunrun representatives to clarify matters related to this request for information. It is hereby clarified, however, that the staff members and/or consultants are not authorized to make representations or take decisions on behalf of the Energy Bureau.

The Energy Bureau **WARNS** Sunrun that:


- (i) noncompliance with this Resolution and Order, regulations and/or applicable laws may carry the imposition of fines and administrative sanctions of up to \$25,000 per day;
- (ii) any person who intentionally violates Act 57-2014, as amended, by omitting, disregarding, or refusing to obey, observe, and comply with any rule or decision of the Energy Bureau shall be punished by a fine of not less than five hundred dollars (\$500) nor over five thousand dollars (\$5,000) at the discretion of the Energy Bureau; and
- (iii) for any recurrence of non-compliance or violation, the established penalty shall increase to a fine of not less than ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) nor greater than twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) at the discretion of the Energy Bureau.





## ATTACHMENT A

1. For the years ending on December 31 of 2021, 2022, and 2023, please provide the following information:

A clear statement of the gross revenue attributable only to the sale of energy in Puerto Rico, and the corresponding combined or branch financial statements for those same entities' activities related to the sale of energy in Puerto Rico. To respond to this request, please follow these instructions and/or provide the additional information requested:

- a. For lease-type agreements, specify which type of lease is used (operating or capital lease) and identify the owner of the assets that generate and sell energy. Also, provide sample copies of the relevant lease-type agreements.
  - b. For PPOAs<sup>3</sup>, specify the structures typically used and identify who—if not Sunrun, Inc.—owns, generates, and sells the energy. Also, provide sample copies of the relevant PPOAs.
  - c. Exclude from Puerto Rico generated revenues those that are not required to be reported, such as operations & maintenance, among others.
  - d. For each sale of energy revenue, specify which entity actually generates and sells the energy.
2. Provide the most recent organizational chart of Sunrun Inc.'s affiliates, subsidiaries, and/or partnership limited liability companies that operate in Puerto Rico ("Entities").
    - a. This information must reconcile with the 119 active legal Entities registered in Puerto Rico as of April 15, 2024.
