**MOTION TO REITERATE THE REQUEST FOR THE REVIEW AND APPROVAL OF CERTAIN
PPOAS AND ESSAS AMENDMENTS BY THE ENERGY BUREAU**

TO THE HONORABLE PUERTO RICO ENERGY BUREAU:

COMES NOW the Puerto Rico Power Authority ("PREPA"), through its counsel of record, and respectfully submits and prays as follows:

1. As previously informed to the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board ("Energy Bureau"), on August 26th, 2022, PREPA and Clean Flexible Energy, LLC (CFE) signed two Power Purchase Operating Agreements ("POAs"). The first is 2023-P00054 for the Salinas Project, and the second is 2023-P00055 for the Jobos Project. On the same date, PREPA and CFE signed the Energy Storage Services Agreement ("ESSA") 2023-P00053 for the Salinas Battery Project and 2023-P00052 for the Jobos Battery Project.
2. The agreements have undergone several amendments. On April 16th, 2024, PREPA submitted a Proposed Fifth Amendment for the Jobos Battery Project and a Proposed Sixth Amendment for the Salinas Battery Project to the

Energy Bureau for review and approval. The proposed amendments concern increasing the battery project's capacity.

3. Additionally, on May 31st, 2024, PREPA requested the Energy Bureau's evaluation and approval of (1) the Sixth Amendment for the Jobos Battery Project, (2) the Seventh Amendment for the Salinas Battery Project, (3) the Sixth Amendment for the Salinas PPOA, and (4) the Seventh Amendment for the Jobos PPOA. These amendments are part of the financing process between CFE and the Department of Energy's Loan Program Office (LPO).
4. The Energy Bureau has yet to rule on the proposed amendments.
5. The approval of these amendments is critical for the continuation and successful implementation of the Jobos and Salinas Projects, which are needed to enhance the reliability and sustainability of Puerto Rico's electric grid.
6. PREPA respectfully reiterates its request and urges the Energy Bureau to approve the proposed amendments. The timely approval is necessary to maintain the project schedule and meet the financial and operational milestones.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons stated above, PREPA respectfully requests that the Energy Bureau take **NOTICE** of the present Motion and **APPROVE** the proposed amendments.
