**SUBJECT:** Motion to Request Extension of Time

**RESOLUTION AND ORDER**

On July 17, 2024, the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board (“Energy Bureau”) issued a Resolution and Order (“July 17 Order”) in which it ordered CEN JUNCOS SOLAR, LLC (“CEN JUNCOS”) to, on or before fifteen (15) days, from the notification date, (i) submit a detailed explanation of the discrepancies between the two reported Gross Revenues and the financial statements for the natural year ending on December 31, 2023 in compliance with Section 4.02(H) of Regulation 8701<sup>1</sup>, (ii) submit the Financial Statements certified by a CPA in compliance with Section 4.02(E) of Regulation 8701, and (iii) submit an amended Gross Revenue and Financial Statements Form (NEPR-B05).

On August 1, 2024, CEN JUNCOS filed a document titled *Motion to Request Extension of Time* (“August 1 Request”) in the captioned case. CEN JUNCOS request a sixty (60) days extension to submit a detailed explanation of the discrepancies between the two reported Gross Revenues and financial statements and the Amended Gross Revenue and Financial Statements Form (NEPR-B05), alleging that to prepare a detailed explanation for the discrepancies, it will require the Certified Public Accountant (“CPA”) to examine a vast number of documents, which hinders the ability to inform the Energy Bureau within the time frame given in the July 16 Order. Also, CEN JUNCOS informs that the contracted CPA is extremely occupied with other corporate filings that are not under the purview of the Energy Bureau.<sup>2</sup>


The Energy Bureau **TAKES NOTICE** of CEN JUNCOS’s request and **GRANTS** CEN JUNCOS until **September 30, 2024** to comply with the July 17 Order.

The Energy Bureau **WARNS** CEN JUNCOS that non-compliance with Energy Bureau’s orders and regulations may carry the imposition additional administrative fines.



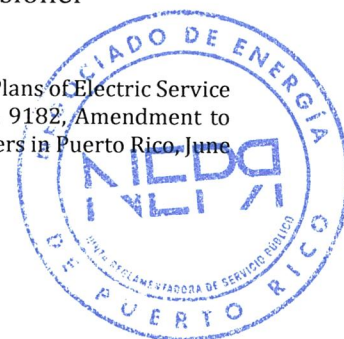
