Motion in Compliance with Resolution and
Order of August 23, 2024

MOTION IN COMPLIANCE WITH RESOLUTION AND ORDER OF AUGUST 23, 2024

TO THE ENERGY BUREAU:

COMES NOW, GENERA PR, LLC (“Genera”), through its undersigned counsel and, very respectfully, states and prays as follows:

1. On June 13, 2024, the Puerto Rico Energy Bureau (“PREB”) issued a *Resolution and Order* instructing the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority (“PREPA”), LUMA Energy, LLC and Luma Energy ServCo, LLC (“LUMA”), and Genera PR LLC (“Genera”), to elaborate and present to the PREB their respective Electric System Stabilization Plans (“Preliminary Plan”). The *Preliminary Plans* were to be presented by July 3, 2024.

2. All parties requested a twenty-day extension to the filing deadline. However, on July 5, 2024, the PREB issued a *Resolution and Order* denying the extension requests. The PREB further ordered LUMA, Genera and PREPA to show cause, on or before July 10, 2024, stating the reasons an administrative fine of up to \$25,000.00 should not be imposed upon them for each day of delay in the presentation of their respective *Preliminary Plans*.

3. On July 8, 2024, Genera filed a motion through which the *Preliminary Plan* was presented as Attachment A.

4. On July 11, 2024, the PREB acknowledged receipt of Genera’s *Preliminary Plan* and noted that the document met the basic expectations of the PREB.

5. On August 23, 2024, the PREB issued a *Resolution and Order* imposing an administrative fine of \$500.00 for each day in which LUMA, Genera and PREPA delayed the presentation of their respective *Preliminary Plans*. A fine of \$2,500.00 was imposed on Genera for presenting its *Preliminary Plan* five days after the July 3, 2024 deadline.

6. Genera respectfully informs that, on September 10, 2024, the \$2,500.00 fine was paid through a wire transfer (**Exhibit 1**). Thus, Genera has fully complied with the *Resolution and Order* of August 23, 2024.

WHEREFORE, Genera respectfully requests PREB to take notice of the foregoing and deem Genera in compliance with the Resolution and Order of August 23, 2024.
