**RESOLUTION AND ORDER**

On September 23, 2024, Enernet CHP ONE, LLC (“Enernet CHP One”) filed before the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board (“Energy Bureau”) a *Motion to Request Certification as an Electric Service Company, to Request Certification as Highly Efficiency Generation, and to Request Confidential Treatment*. On the request, Enernet CHP One requested that the Energy Bureau (i) certify Enernet CHP One as an Electric Service Company under Regulation No. 8701<sup>1</sup>, (ii) certify that the CHP system meets the definition of “Highly Efficient Generation” for Act No. 60-2019<sup>2</sup>, and (iii) provide confidential treatment to certain information filed with the Application. Enernet CHP One also requested a waiver to submit information in their own format rather than using the Energy Bureau’s standard forms.

On October 23, 2024, the Energy Bureau issue a Resolution and Order (“October 23 Resolution”) through which granted the Enernet CHP One its request for confidential designation of the documents filed confidentially, denied the request for waiver to submit information in their own format rather than using the Energy Bureau’s standard forms, and determined the Application did not meet the requirement established in Regulation 8701. The Energy Bureau granted fifteen (15) days from the notification of the Resolution and Order to provide information identified on the Resolution and Order to consider the Application complete for evaluation to certified Enernet CHP One as an Electric Service Company and deferred the request for Highly Efficient Generation certification until the Application is complete.

On November 7, 2024, Enernet CHP One filed before the Energy Bureau a document titled *Motion to Request an Extension to Comply with the October 23, 2024 Resolution and Order* through which requested until November 28, 2024 to comply with the October 23 Resolution.






