RESOLUTION

On December 4, 2024, the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board ("Energy Bureau") ordered LUMA Energy, LLC and LUMA Energy ServCo, LLC (referred to jointly as "LUMA") to provide, within seven (7) days, evidence that the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority ("PREPA") approved the filed *Accelerated Storage Addition Program* ("ASAP") Phase 1 Standard Offer Agreements ("SO Agreements").

On December 10, 2024, PREPA filed a document titled *Informative Motion* ("December 10 Motion"), in which it informed that, through Resolution 5163 submitted as Exhibit 1 to the December 10 Motion, PREPA's Governing Board approved three (3) SO Phase 1 Agreements.¹ PREPA also submitted the referenced agreements as approved by its Governing Board as Exhibits 2, 3, and 4 to the December 10 Motion.

On December 11, 2024, LUMA filed a document titled Informative Motion and to Submit Evidence of PREPA Governing Board Approval of Three Phase 1 SO Agreements, In Compliance with Resolution and Order of December 4, 2024, and Request for Confidentiality ("December 11 Motion"). In its December 11 Motion, LUMA submitted that its statement regarding the approval of the three (3) SO Phase 1 Agreements by PREPA's Governing Board was based on a recording of PREPA's Governing Board held on November 18, 2024 and provided a link to the recording.² LUMA also referenced the written resolution of this determination submitted by PREPA in its December 10 Motion.³ Additionally, LUMA informed that on November 26, 2024, PREPA requested LUMA to correct minor typographical errors in the three (3) SO Phase 1 Agreements to finalize them (identified in Exhibit 1 to the December 11 Motion), which LUMA did and submitted to PREPA on December 6, 2024.⁴ LUMA further requested that the Energy Bureau grant confidential treatment to Exhibit 1 to the December 11 Motion and filed a redacted version as the public version of the Exhibit. LUMA stated that Exhibit 1 includes confidential trade secret information and personal information that should not be disclosed, including the names of Phase 1 participants, as well as names of individuals, phone numbers, and email addresses, which LUMA submitted should remain confidential until the respective SO Agreements are executed.⁵

The Energy Bureau **TAKES NOTICE** of the December 10 and 11 Motions. Regarding Exhibits 2, 3, and 4 to the December 10 Motion (SO Agreements), the Energy Bureau **GRANTS** confidential designation and treatment on the grounds of containing trade secrets, in
