**SUBJECT:** Resolution *Nun Pro Tunc*; Correction on Attachment B for Determination on the Request by LUMA for Partial Reconsideration on the FY 2025 Annual Budgets and Requirement of Information ("ROI").

### **RESOLUTION NUNC PRO TUNC**

On December 2, 2024, the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board ("Energy Bureau") issued a Resolution and Order ("December 2 Order"), through which, among other determinations, it reconsidered its decision to increase the operational budget allocation for LUMA's¹ Vegetation Management activities by an additional \$13.507 million, and adjusted the budget for the Vegetation Management program to LUMA's original request of \$50 million.

On December 23, 2024, LUMA filed a document titled *Request to Amend Attachment B of the December 2 2024 Resolution and Order* ("December 23 Motion"), through which LUMA identified to the Energy Bureau, a possible clerical error that could create confusion in Attachment B, REVISED FY 2025 T&D Operating Budget, included with the December 2 Order.

On page 14, titled **Attachment B,** in the December 2 Order, the footnote for "Operations" budget states: "Vegetation Management and Capital Clearing Implementation funding: \$221,707 (OpEx portion \$63,507)". The Energy Bureau **CORRECTS** the amount for Vegetation Management and Capital Clearing to \$50,000.

Accordingly, the Energy Bureau **CORRECTS** said clerical error through this Resolution. The footnote now read as follows:

Vegetation Management and Capital Clearing Implementation funding: \$221,707 (OpEx portion \$50,000).
