RESOLUTION

On March 3, 2025, Sunrun, Inc. ("Sunrun") filed before the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board ("Energy Bureau") two versions of the document titled *Motion to Request Confidential Treatment of Gross Revenues Report* ("March 3 Motion"), with the following documents:

- 1. Unredacted version of the March 3 Motion with an unredacted *Gross Revenue and Financial Statements Report Electric Power Companies* (Form NEPR-B05), identified as Attachment 1.
- 2. Redacted version of the March 3 Motion with a redacted *Gross Revenue and Financial Statements Report Electric Power Companies* (Form NEPR-B05), identified as Attachment 1.

In the unredacted version of the March 3 Motion Sunrun requested confidential treatment to the unredacted motion and its attached unredacted Form NEPR-B05.

Section 4.02(A) of Regulation 8701¹ requires that all electric service companies must inform their Annual Gross Revenue within sixty (60) days after the end of the preceding Natural Year. The Form established by the Energy Bureau for this information is the *Gross Revenue* and Financial Statements Report (Form NEPR-B05).

The Energy Bureau **DETERMINES** Sunrun has complied with Section 4.02 of Regulation 8701 submitting Form NEPR-B05.

Sunrun submitted redacted and unredacted versions of the March 3 Motion and Form NEPR-B05 complying with Section 6.15 of Act 57-2014², Section 1.15 of Regulation 8701 and the *In Re: Policy on Management of Confidential Information in Procedures before the Commission*, CEPR-MI-2016-009, August 31-2016 Resolution ("Confidential Treatment Resolution").

The Energy Bureau **TAKES NOTICE** of the information presented by Sunrun in the unredacted version of the March 3 Motion and upon an examination of the arguments brought forth by Sunrun, the Energy Bureau **GRANTS** confidential designation and treatment to the unredacted version of the March 3 Motion and the attached unredacted *Gross Revenue and Financial Statements Report Electric Power Companies* (Form NEPR-B05), identified as Attachment 1, under Act 57-2014 and Regulation 8701.
