SUBJECT: Oversight Field Visits at AES and
EcoElectrica.

MOTION IN COMPLIANCE WITH RESOLUTION AND ORDER OF MARCH 24, 2025

COMES NOW EcoEléctrica, L.P. (referred to as "EcoEléctrica"), through the undersigned counsel, and respectfully states the following:

1. Act 57-2014 created the Energy Bureau and granted it broad regulatory authority over Puerto Rico's energy sector, including oversight of contracts that impact electricity rates, service quality, and system reliability.
2. EcoEléctrica has in effect a Power Purchase and Operating Agreements with the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority (as amended or supplemented, the "PPOAs") and is one of the largest energy PPOA providers and has a significant role in the generation reliability of the energy system of Puerto Rico.
3. The Energy Bureau initiated a Project Inspection program intended to inspect the status of the improvement and maintenance projects related to the implementation of the Integrated Resources Plan ("IRP").
4. As part of such program, the Energy Bureau already formalized and documented through a Resolution and Order the scheduled oversight field visits to the Genera PR, LLC generation sites.
5. The Energy Bureau has indicated that since Blue sky outages and controlled load shedding have continued to affect the people of Puerto Rico, it has become necessary to obtain detailed information regarding the circumstances that have led to constraints in the available generation capacity to meet peak demand.

6. Since EcoEléctrica is one of the largest energy PPOA providers to LUMA and has a significant role in the generation reliability of the energy system of Puerto Rico, the Energy Bureau has decided to include EcoEléctrica in its monitoring strategy.
7. The Energy Bureau has indicated that it will concentrate, among other things, on the status of the site, list of jobs and preventive/corrective maintenance schedules, percentage of completion of each job and the expected completion date. The uptime of the Units will be discussed and monitored, understanding of reasons for generation limitations and downtime if applicable. Subsequent follow-ups on problems and actions identified in prior visits, once the process starts, will be watched.
8. That as part of such inspection program, the Energy Bureau issued a Resolution and Order on March 24th, 2025 requiring EcoEléctrica to: (i) designate pertinent directive level staff to immediately start the coordination of the Energy Bureau's planned site visits; (ii) within 10 days of the issuance of this Resolution and Order, provide names, titles and contact information so that the visiting teams can communicate directly and start the scheduling of site visits to each of the generation sites.
9. In compliance with the March 24th Resolution and Order, EcoEléctrica notifies to the Energy Bureau that EcoEléctrica's designated contact for the coordination of the Energy Bureau's planned visits to its site will be: Rafael Quintana, Plant Manager; email: rafael.quintana@ecoelectrica.com; phone: (787) 222-6376.

WHEREFORE, EcoEléctrica respectfully requests that the Energy Bureau take notice of the aforementioned and deem that EcoEléctrica has complied with the March 24, 2025, Resolution and Order.
