MOTION TO SUBMIT PREPA'S FEDERAL FUNDING AND GRID MODERNIZATION IMPLEMENTATION REPORT FOR MARCH 2025

COMES NOW the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority ("PREPA"), through its counsel of record, and respectfully submits and requests as follows:

- On June 25, 2023, the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory
 Board ("Energy Bureau") issued a Resolution and Order modifying and, as
 such, approving the Consolidated Annual Budgets for Fiscal Year 2024
 (hereinafter, the "June 25th Resolution").
- 2. In addition, the Energy Bureau directed PREPA to present the Implementation of the Grid Modernization Plan on a bi-monthly basis (hereinafter, the "Grid Modernization Report"). Per the June 25th Resolution, the Grid Modernization Report shall include a comprehensive overview of the primary investment areas and projects being considered by PREPA to ensure the provision of dependable and resilient power, along with the current progress of project milestones.
- 3. PREPA was also ordered to submit monthly reports with the Energy Bureau detailing federal funding activity during the quarter for hydro facilities,

including progress on submitting and advancing PWs and Scopes of Work (SOWs), by hydro/dam site, the cumulative amount of federal funding applied for, the incremental amount of federal funding applied for in the reporting quarter and both the cumulative and monthly amount of federal funding received.

- 4. On November 13, 2023, the Energy Bureau issued a Resolution and Order to authorize, among other things, a monthly cadence for the Grid Modernization Implementation Report.
- 5. Moreover, on June 26, 2024, the Energy Bureau issued a Resolution and Order regarding the FY 2025 Budget review. The Energy Bureau determined that the FY 2025 Budgets, as modified by the Resolution and Order, comply with Act 57-2014 and the 2017 Rate Order. Furthermore, the Energy Bureau indicated that "[a]|| existing Reporting Requirements remain in full force and effect".
- 6. On March 31st, 2025, PREPA requested a ten (10) day extension to submit the Grid Modernization report.
- 7. In compliance with Energy Bureau's order, PREPA submits the Federal Funding and Grid Modernization Implementation Report.

WHEREFORE, PREPA respectfully requests the Energy Bureau to take NOTICE of the information provided and FIND PREPA in compliance with the reporting requirements of the June 25 Order.
