RESOLUTION

On March 3, 2025, CEN JUNCOS SOLAR II LLC ("CEN JUNCOS II") filed before the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board ("Energy Bureau") a document titled *Motion to Request Confidential Treatment of 2025 Gross Revenues Report* ("March 3 Motion"), which included the following documents:

Attachment 1. Unredacted version of the form *Gross Revenue and Financial Statements Report Electric Power Companies* (Form NEPR-B05).

Attachment 2. Redacted version of the form *Gross Revenue and Financial Statements Report Electric Power Companies* (Form NEPR-B05).

In the March 3 Motion CEN JUNCOS II requested that all the information in the motion and the attached documents be granted confidential treatment.

Section 4.02(A) of Regulation 8701<sup>1</sup> requires that that all electric service companies must inform their Annual Gross Revenue within sixty (60) days after the end of the preceding Natural Year. The Form established by the Energy Bureau for this information is the *Gross Revenue and Financial Statements Report* (Form NEPR-B05).

The Energy Bureau **DETERMINES** CEN JUNCOS II has complied with Section 4.02(A) of Regulation 8701 submitting Form NEPR-B05.

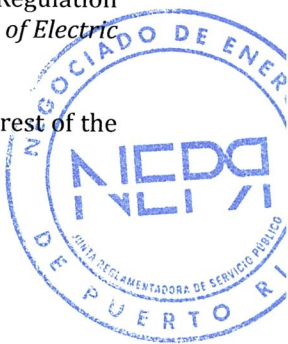
On March 31, 2025, CEN JUNCOS II filed two identical versions of the document titled *Motion to Request Confidential Treatment of 2025 Operational Report* ("March 31 Motion"), each one with a different document:

1. Motion with unredacted *Operational Report Electric Power Companies* (Form NEPR-B03) and unredacted evidence of the corresponding filing fee<sup>2</sup>.
2. Motion with redacted *Operational Report Electric Power Companies* (Form NEPR-B03) and redacted evidence of the corresponding filing fee.

In the March 31 Motions, CEN JUNCOS II requested that all the information contained in the motions and the attached documents be granted confidential treatment.

Section 2.02(A)(1) of Regulation 8701 requires that electric service companies who offer electric power generation services for sale in Puerto Rico through distributed generators interconnected to PREPA’s power grid with an aggregate capacity of one megawatt (1 MW) or more, must file annually an Operational Report before the Energy Bureau. The Form established by the Energy Bureau for this information is the *Operational Report Electric Power Companies* (Form NEPR-B03).

The Energy Bureau **DETERMINES** CEN JUNCOS II **COMPLIED** with Section 2.02(A)(1) of Regulation 8701 submitting Form NEPR-B03.

CEN JUNCOS II submitted redacted and unredacted versions of the documents in the March 3 Motion and the March 31 Motion complying with Section 6.15 of Act 57-2014<sup>3</sup>, Section 1.15 of Regulation 8701 and the *In Re: Policy on Management of Confidential Information in Procedures before the Commission*, CEPR-MI-2016-009, August 31-2016 Resolution (“Confidential Treatment Resolution”).

The Energy Bureau **TAKES NOTICE** of the Information presented by CEN JUNCOS II in the March 3 Motion and upon an examination of the arguments brought forth by CEN JUNCOS, the Energy Bureau **DENIES** CEN JUNCOS request for confidential treatment to the motion and Attachment 2 since the motion and Attachment 2 doesn’t contain confidential information and thus doesn’t need confidential treatment, and **GRANTS** confidential designation and treatment to the unredacted version of the *Gross Revenue and Financial Statements Report Electric Power Companies* (Form NEPR-B05), included as Attachment 1, under Act 57-2014 and Regulation 8701.

The Energy Bureau **TAKES NOTICE** of the Information presented by CEN JUNCOS II in the March 31 Motions and upon an examination of the arguments brought forth by CEN JUNCOS II, the Energy Bureau **GRANTS** confidential designation and treatment to the unredacted *Operational Report Electric Power Companies* (Form NEPR-B03), included as attachment of one of the March 31 Motions, under Act 57-2014 and Regulation 8701.


