RESOLUTION

On March 31, 2025, CIRO ONE SALINAS, LLC ("CIRO ONE SALINAS") filed before the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board ("Energy Bureau") a document titled *Motion to Request Confidential Treatment of 2025 Operational Report and Annexes* ("March 31 Motion"), with the following documents:

- 1. Unredacted version of *Operational Report Electric Power Companies* (Form NEPR-B03) and unredacted annexes, identified as Attachment 1.
- 2. Redacted version of *Operational Report Electric Power Companies* (Form NEPR-B03) and redacted annexes identified as Attachment 1.

In the March 31 Motion CIRO ONE SALINAS requested that all the information in the motion and the attached documents be granted confidential treatment.

CIRO ONE SALINAS requested from the Energy Bureau a waiver from the payment of the filing fee of the Operational Report because its system is not yet operational and is not generating revenue. They alleged that the payment of the corresponding fee for the submission of the Operational Report will result in an onerous situation for the company.

Section 2.02 of Regulation 8701¹ requires that all electric service companies must submit an Operational Report². The form established by the Energy Bureau for this information is the *Operational Report Electric Services Companies* (Form NEPR-B03).

The Energy Bureau **DETERMINES** CIRO ONE SALINAS has complied with Section 2.02 of Regulation 8701 submitting Form NEPR-B03.

CIRO ONE SALINAS submitted redacted and unredacted versions of the Form NEPR-B03 complying with Section 6.15 of Act 57-2014³, Section 1.15 of Regulation 8701 and the *In Re: Policy on Management of Confidential Information in Procedures before the Commission*, CEPR-MI-2016-009, August 31-2016 Resolution ("Confidential Treatment Resolution").

The Energy Bureau **TAKES NOTICE** of the Information presented by CIRO ONE SALINAS in the March 31 Motion and upon an examination of the arguments brought forth by CIRO ONE SALINAS, the Energy Bureau **GRANTS** confidential designation and treatment to the unredacted *Operational Report Electric Services Companies* (Form NEPR-B03) and its annexes, identified as Attachment 1, under Act 57-2014 and Regulation 8701.

Under the circumstances the Energy Bureau **WAIVES** the payment of amount corresponding to the fee for the submission of the Operational Report.
