**SUBJECT:** Motion to Submit Status Report  
for the Third Quarter of Fiscal Year 2025

**MOTION TO SUBMIT STATUS REPORT  
FOR THE THIRD QUARTER OF FISCAL YEAR 2025**

**TO THE HONORABLE PUERTO RICO ENERGY BUREAU:**

**COMES NOW GENERA PR LLC** (“Genera”), as agent of the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority (“PREPA”),<sup>1</sup> through its counsels of record, and respectfully submits and prays as follows:

1. Pursuant to the Resolution and Order issued by the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board (“Energy Bureau”) on March 26, 2021, in Case No. NEPR-MI-2021-0002 (“March 26<sup>th</sup> Resolution”),<sup>2</sup> Genera, acting as PREPA's agent, is required to submit each specific capital investment project for approval to avoid potential noncompliance with the Approved Integrated Resource Plan (“IRP”) and Modified Action Plan. To streamline this process, in accordance with the March 26<sup>th</sup> Resolution, Genera must

submit these specific projects at least thirty (30) calendar days before their submission to the Puerto Rico Central Office for Recovery, Reconstruction and Resiliency (“COR3”), the Federal Emergency Management Agency (“FEMA”), or any other federal agency. Additionally, Genera is to continue reporting the progress of all ongoing efforts related to the final approval of the submitted projects not yet approved by the Energy Bureau to both the Energy Bureau and FEMA over the next five (5) years.

2. On February 8, 2024, the Energy Bureau issued a Resolution and Order initiating the instant proceeding (“February 8<sup>th</sup> Order”) with the purpose of maintaining a clearer, organized, and updated record of all projects approved by the Energy Bureau in Case No.: NEPR-MI-2021-0002, along with the phases of execution in which they are.

3. Pertinent to this motion, the February 8<sup>th</sup> Order LUMA,<sup>3</sup> Genera and PREPA to present quarterly status reports for the update, monitoring, and effective management of such projects every March 31, June 30, September 30, and December 31 of each year, including the current year, starting on March 31, 2024.

4. In compliance with the February 8<sup>th</sup> Order, Genera hereby submits to the Energy Bureau, attached as *Exhibit A* to this Motion, its status report for the third quarter of Fiscal Year 2025, ending March 31, 2025 (“Fiscal Year 2025 Third Quarter Status Report”), containing the status information of the projects approved by the Energy Bureau.

**WHEREFORE**, Genera respectfully requests that this Energy Bureau **take notice** of the above for all relevant purposes and **deem** Genera to be in compliance with the February 8<sup>th</sup> Order as it pertains to the submission of the Fiscal Year 2025 Third Quarter Status Report.
