RESOLUTION AND ORDER

I. Introduction

On February 28, 2025, ROOFTOP SOLAR JV, LLC (“ROOFTOP”) filed before the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board (“Energy Bureau”) its 2024 Annual Gross Revenue Report (FORM NEPR-B05).

On March 4, 2025, ROOFTOP submitted its financial statements for Fiscal Year 2024.

On March 11, 2025, ROOFTOP provided evidence of payment of the filing fee in connection with ROOFTOP’S Form of Personal Information (Form NEPR-B01), as requested by the Energy Bureau through a Resolution and Order issued on February 21, 2025 (“February 21 Order”). ROOFTOP clarified the intent for the filing of Form NEPR-B01 was to update information.

On March 31, 2025, ROOFTOP submitted its *Operational Report* for 2025 (Form NEPR-B03). ROOFTOP also provided evidence of payment for the filing of Form NEPR-B03.

II. Applicable Laws and Regulations

A. Operational Report

JMA Pursuant to Section 2.02 of Regulation 8701¹ all electric service companies must submit an operational report with the frequency corresponding to their classification.² The required format for such reports is the Operation Report for Electric Power Companies (Form NEPR-B03), as established by the Energy Bureau.

AMU In addition, Section 2.03(A)(2) of Regulation 8701 mandates that all electric service companies submitting an operational report must pay the applicable fee.

B. Duty to Inform Annual Gross Revenue and Financial Statements


DM Section 4.02 (A) and (B) of Regulation 8701 states that all electric companies operating in Puerto Rico shall inform the Energy Bureau of their annual gross revenue within a period of sixty (60) days following the conclusion of the Natural Year.

AMU Section 4.02 (E) and (F) of Regulation 8701 establishes that electric service companies must submit their financial statements within one hundred and twenty (120) days after the end of their Fiscal Year. The financial statements must be certified by a CPA authorized to practice said profession in Puerto Rico, or in any jurisdiction of the United States of America.³

Section 4.02(E) requires compiled financial statements for electric service companies with three million dollars (\$3,000,000) or less in annual gross revenue. Section 4.02(F) of



For companies whose fiscal year runs from January 1 to December 31, 2024, the due date for filing was April 30, 2025.⁴

III. Conclusion

The Energy Bureau **TAKES NOTICE** that ROOFTOP has submitted its Operational Report, Annual Gross Revenue, and Financial Statements. The Energy Bureau further **DETERMINES** ROOFTOP has complied with Section 2.03(A)(2) by submitting evidence of payment of the applicable filing fee.

The Energy Bureau **DETERMINES** ROOFTOOP has complied with the February 21 Order, in accordance with Section 2.03(A)(1)(a).


