MOTION TO COMPLY WITH PREB RESOLUTION AND ORDER

TO THE HONORABLE ENERGY BUREAU:

COMES NOW SunEdison Puerto Rico, LLC ("SunEdison") represented by the undersigned legal counsel, and very respectfully prays and requests:

1. On June 26, 2025, the Honorable Energy Bureau issued a Resolution and Order (*"June 26th Resolution and Order"*) wherein it ordered SunEdison to, on or before fifteen (15) days from the notification of the *June 26th Resolution and Order* to (1) submit the credentials of the entity contracted to operate its system, as required under Section 2.02 (A)(1)(d) of Regulation 8701 and detailed above, and (2) submit its Financial Statements for Fiscal Year 2024, which were due April 30, 2025.

2. First, SunEdison respectfully clarifies that, although information was provided in the section designated for the operator entity, the same contact information submitted corresponds to the individual identified as the principal point of contact before the Energy Bureau¹. We regret any confusion this may have caused. At this time, the system is not operational, and no third-party operator has been contracted nor is one

currently being considered. Accordingly, we submit that the requirement to provide operator credentials does not apply under the current circumstances.

3. With regards to the requirement to submit Financial Statements for Fiscal Year

2024, SunEdison reiterates that the system is not operational and, therefore, is not

generating any revenue.² This fact was previously communicated to the Energy Bureau.

Given the absence of income-generating activity, we respectfully understand that the

requirement to file financial statements should not apply, as any such report would likely

reflect only operating losses, not meaningful financial data.

4. SunEdison requests that the information contained in the attachments and this

motion be kept confidential. Section 6.15 of Act No. 57 of May 17, 2014, as amended,

provides:

If a person having the obligation to submit information to the Energy Commission understands the information to be submitted is privileged or confidential, [such person] may request said Commission to give [privileged or confidential] treatment subject to the following:

(a) if the Energy Commission, after due evaluation, understands the information should be protected, it shall find a way to grant this protection in the manner that impacts less the public, transparency and the rights of the parties involved in the administrative proceeding under which the alleged confidential document is being filed.

(b) To such effects, the Energy Commission may grant access to the document, or to portions of the document that are privileged, only to counsel and external consultants involved in the administrative proceeding after execution of a confidentiality agreement.

(c) The Energy Commission shall keep documents presented before it completely out of public scrutiny only in exceptional cases. In such cases, the information shall be duly safeguarded and delivered exclusively to Energy Commission personnel on a need-to-know basis,

under non-disclosure rules. However, the Energy Commission shall order that a non-confidential version for public review be submitted.

(d) Any claim of privileged or confidential information by a person under the jurisdiction of the Energy Commission must be ruled in an expedited manner by the Commission through a resolution to such effects, before any confidential information alleged by a party is disclosed.

5. In turn, Section 1.15 of the Regulation No. 8701 provides that when a person who is required to submit information to the Energy Bureau considers such information to be privileged or confidential, the person shall identify the information it deems privileged or confidential, request the Energy Bureau to protect such information, and present arguments supporting the privilege or confidentiality claim. The Energy Bureau shall evaluate the petition and, if it concludes the information merits protection, it shall proceed pursuant to Section 6.15 of Act No. 57.

1. SunEdison is a privately held company, and its financial information, contained in this motion and attachments, is confidential, of sensitive nature, and not available to the public. The disclosure of SunEdison financial and contact information would place it at a competitive disadvantage with respect to other market participants and cause it economic harm.

6. In compliance with Section 6.15 of Act 57-2014, Section 1.15 of Regulation 8701 and the In Re: Policy on Management of Confidential Information in Procedures Before the Commission, CEPR-MI-2016-0009, August 31-2016, Resolution ("Confidential Treatment Resolution"), SunEdison is filing a redacted and unredacted version of the information and documents for which it is requesting Confidential Treatment. WHEREFORE, SunEdison Puerto Rico, LLC respectfully requests that the Honorable Energy Bureau take notice of its submission in response to the June 26th Resolution and Order, and consider that, given the system is not operational, no thirdparty operator has been contracted or designated, and no revenues have been generated during Fiscal Year 2024, the requirements to submit operator credentials and financial statements should not apply under the current circumstances.
