	<b>SUBJECT</b> : Resolution and Order pertaining to <i>Urgent Request for Extension of Time to</i> <i>Comply with the July 9, 2025 Order to Show</i> <i>Cause</i> , filed by LUMA Energy, LLC and LUMA Energy ServCo, LLC.

## **RESOLUTION AND ORDER**

On July 9, 2025, the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board ("Energy Bureau") ordered LUMA<sup>1</sup> to show cause within five (5) days as to why it should not: 1) be fined \$100,000 for willful non-compliance and misrepresentation of material facts regarding Phase 1 of the Accelerated Storage Addition Program ("ASAP"); and 2) have its interconnection-related costs disallowed for Phase One Standard Offer Projects, as those costs were not disclosed or justified during the approval process ("July 9 Order"). Particularly, because LUMA had explicitly stated that Phase 1 would require no network upgrades or interconnection costs, which was a key basis for the Energy Bureau's approval. However, LUMA later submitted documentation showing \$1.3 million in interconnection study costs, directly contradicting its prior representations.

On July 11, 2025, LUMA filed a document titled *Urgent Request for Extension of Time to Comply with the July 9, 2025 Order to Show Cause* ("July 11 Motion"). Through the July 11 Motion, LUMA requested five (5) additional days to respond to the July 9 Order, citing the seriousness and complexity of the issues raised.

Upon review of the July 11 Motion, the Energy Bureau **GRANTS** LUMA **five (5) additional days** to comply with the July 9 Order.

The Energy Bureau **REITERATES** that failure from LUMA to timely respond to this Resolution and Order will result in the imposition of fines, in accordance with Section 6.36 of Act 57-2014.<sup>2</sup>
