**MOTION IN COMPLIANCE WITH
JUNE 23 RESOLUTION AND ORDER**

TO THE HONORABLE ENERGY BUREAU:

COMES NOW, Pattern Santa Isabel, LLC (“Pattern”), represented by the undersigned legal counsel, and respectfully submits the following:

1. On June 23, 2025, the Honorable Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board (the “Energy Bureau”) issued a Resolution and Order (the “June 23 R&O”) finding that: (a) Pattern had failed to remit the full filing fee required under Section 2.03(A)(2)(c) of Regulation 8701 in connection with its 2025 Operational Report, and was required to pay the outstanding balance of \$1,200 within fifteen (15) days; and (b) Pattern was required to provide a detailed description of the credentials, services, equipment, and systems of the third-party contractor engaged to operate its facility, including proof of the contractor’s legal personality, operational capacity, and technical qualifications.

2. In compliance with the June 23 R&O, Pattern has paid the outstanding balance of \$1,200 as required by Section 2.03(A)(2)(c) of Regulation No. 8701. Evidence of payment is attached hereto as **Attachment 1**.
3. Further in compliance with the June 23 R&O, Pattern also submits the requested documentation concerning its former third-party contractor, Siemens Gamesa Renewable Energy, Inc. (“SGRE”), which operated the facility prior to Pattern’s transition to self-operation on September 16, 2023.
4. Specifically, **Attachment 2** includes documentation evidencing SGRE’s legal personality and authority to conduct business in Puerto Rico, while **Attachment 3** contains a detailed roster of SGRE personnel assigned to the Pattern Santa Isabel facility during the relevant period, including their names, roles, dates of service, and technical qualifications. The personnel who served at the facility prior to September 16, 2023 were as follows:

5. Pattern requests that confidential treatment be afforded to this motion and its corresponding attachment. Section 6.15 of Act No. 57 of May 17, 2014, as amended, 22 L.P.R.A. § 1054n, provides:

If any person who is required to submit information to the Energy [Bureau] believes that the information to be submitted has any confidentiality privilege, such person may request the [Bureau] to treat such information as such, subject to the following:

(a) If the Energy [Bureau], after the appropriate evaluation, believes such information should be protected, it shall grant such protection in a manner that least affects the public interest, transparency, and the rights of the parties involved in the administrative procedure in which the allegedly confidential document is submitted.

(b) To such purposes, the Energy [Bureau] shall provide access to the document or the privileged portion of the document only to the lawyers and external consultants involved in the administrative process after the execution of a confidentiality agreement.

(c) The Energy [Bureau] shall keep the documents submitted for its consideration out of public reach only in exceptional cases. In these cases, the information shall be duly safeguarded and delivered exclusively to the personnel of the Energy [Bureau] who needs to know such information under nondisclosure agreements. However, the Energy [Bureau] shall direct that a non-confidential copy be furnished for public review.

(d) The Energy [Bureau] shall swiftly act on any privilege and confidentiality claim made by a person subject to its jurisdiction by means of a resolution to such purposes before any allegedly confidential information is disclosed.

6. In turn, Section 1.15 of Regulation 8701 provides that when a person who is required to submit information to the Energy Bureau considers such information to be privileged

or confidential, the person shall identify the information it deems privileged or confidential, request the Energy Bureau to protect such information, and present arguments supporting the privilege or confidentiality claim. The Energy Bureau shall evaluate the petition and, if it concludes the information merits protection, it shall proceed pursuant to Section 6.15 of Act No. 57.

7. Pattern respectfully requests that all the information contained in the attachment hereto be kept confidential in accordance with Section 1.15 of Regulation 8701. In compliance with the process to designate confidential information, Pattern hereby includes redacted and unredacted versions of the document for which confidential treatment is sought.

8. Pattern respectfully requests that this Honorable Energy Bureau only grant access to said information to internal Energy Bureau personnel, counsel, and consultants subject to the execution of a confidentiality agreement.

WHEREFORE, Pattern respectfully submits that it has fully complied with the directives set forth in the June 23 R&O by remitting the outstanding filing fee and submitting the requested information and documentation regarding SGRE's credentials and qualifications. Pattern respectfully requests that the Honorable Energy Bureau take notice of this filing and deem Pattern in compliance with the June 23, 2025 Resolution and Order.
