## **RESOLUTION AND ORDER**

On September 21, 2020, LUMA Energy ServCo ("LUMA") filed before the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board ("Energy Bureau") the following documents:

- 1. *Operational Report Electric Power Companies* (Form NEPR-B03) reporting as type of electric service "Electric Power Billing or Resale".
- 2. *Complementary Sheet* (NEPR Form-Z01) supplementing its Operational Report and reporting:

[I]n this first Operational Report, information will be provided for the category of electric services for "Electric Power Billing or Resale".

These services will include performing all billing and collection services for the T&D System, including collecting charges and enforcing collections. These services will be provided with respect to the clients of PREPA.

Section 2.02 of Regulation 8701<sup>1</sup> requires that all electric service companies must submit an Operational Report with the frequency corresponding to their classification.<sup>2</sup>

As of this date, LUMA has not submitted its *Operational Report for Electric Service Companies* (Form NEPR-B03), required by Section 2.02 of Regulation, with evidence of payment of the applicable filing fee according to the type of electric service to be provided.

The Energy Bureau **ORDERS** LUMA to submit its Operational Report for 2025 and applicable fee, within **ten (10) days** of the notification of this Resolution and Order.

The Energy Bureau **WARNS** LUMA, that, in accordance with Art. 6.36 of Act 57-2014,<sup>3</sup> noncompliance with this Resolution and Order will carry the imposition of fines.
