**SUBJECT:** Resolution pertaining to *Motion in Compliance with June 23 Resolution and Order and Request for Confidential Treatment*, filed by Pattern Santa Isabel, LLC

**RESOLUTION AND ORDER**

On June 23 2025, the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board ("Energy Bureau") issued a Resolution and Order ("June 23 Resolution") granting Pattern Santa Isabel, LLC ("Pattern") fifteen (15) days to submit the credentials of the entity contracted to operate its system, as required under Section 2.02 of Regulation 8701, and to describe what services, equipment, and systems the contracted entity will operate.

In the June 23 Resolution the Energy Bureau further ordered Pattern to submit the remaining amount for the proper filing fee for its *Operational Report for Electric Service Companies* (Form NEPR-B03).

On July 8, 2025, Pattern filed a document titled *Motion to Request Extension of Time* ("July 8 Motion"), requesting a seven (7) day extension to comply with the June 23 Resolution.

On July 15, 2025, Pattern filed a document titled *Motion in Compliance with June 23 Resolution and Order and Request for Confidential Treatment* ("July 15 Motion") to submit the credentials of the entity contracted to operate its system accompanied by the following:

1. Redacted and Unredacted version of the July 8 Motion, including the following redacted and unredacted documents:

Attachment 1 – Evidence of payment of the outstanding balance of the filing fee for its Operational Report.

Attachment 2 – Credentials of the entity contracted to operate Pattern system.

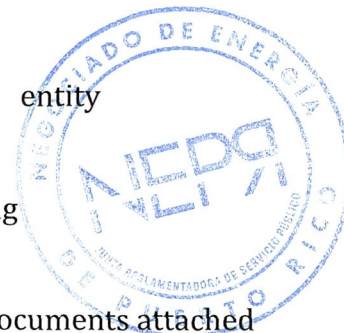
- a. Certificate of Amendment by Puerto Rico Department of State, dated September 24, 2021.
- b. Delaware Secretary of State certifying Certificate of company, dated February 16, 2023.
- c. Certificate of Incorporation by Delaware Department of State, dated September 23, 2022.

- a. Name of Personnel with list of their training with dates.

Pattern requested confidential treatment of the July 15 Motion, and the documents attached to it. Pattern submitted both redacted and unredacted versions of July 15 Motion in compliance with: (i) Section 6.15 of Act 57-2014<sup>1</sup>; (ii) Section 1.15 of Regulation 8701; and


Upon reviewing the documents filed by Pattern in its July 15 Motion, the Energy Bureau **TAKES NOTICE** of the information presented. The Energy Bureau **DETERMINES** Pattern **COMPLIED** with Section 2.02 (A)(1)(d) of Regulation 8701<sup>2</sup> by submitting the credentials of the entity contracted to operate the system and **COMPLIED** with Section 2.03 (A)(2)(c) by providing evidence of payment.

Notwithstanding, in the June 23 Resolution Pattern was also required “to describe what services, equipment, and systems the contracted entity will operate”. Pattern did not provide such information. Hence, the Energy Bureau **GRANTS** PATTERN an additional **ten (10) days** from the notification of this Resolution and Order, to fully comply with the information requested in the June 23 Resolution.




