RESOLUTION AND ORDER

On June 26, 2025, the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board ("Energy Bureau") issued a Resolution and Order ("June 26 Resolution") ordering SunEdison Puerto Rico, LLC ("SunEdison") to submit, within fifteen (15) days:

- 1. The credentials of the entity contracted to operate its system, as required under Section 2.02(A)(1)(d) of Regulation 8701^1 as detailed in the Resolution.
- 2. The Financial Statements for Fiscal Year 2024.

On July 11, 2025, SunEdison filed a document titled *Motion to Comply with PREB Resolution and Order* ("July 11 Motion") accompanied by the following forms for clarification of its request:

1. Redacted and Unredacted version of the July 11 Motion, including redacted and unredacted *Personal Information Electric Service Companies* (Form NEPR-B01)² and redacted and unredacted *Gross Revenue and Financial Statements Report Electric Power Companies* (Form NEPR-B05)³.

SunEdison requested confidential treatment of the July 11 Motion and the Forms attached to it. SunEdison submitted both redacted and unredacted versions of July 11 Motion in compliance with: (i) Section 6.15 of Act 57-2014⁴; (ii) Section 1.15 of Regulation 8701; and (iii) *In Re: Policy on Management of Confidential Information in Procedures before the Commission*, Case No.: CEPR-MI-2016-0009, Resolution and Order issued on August 31, 2016 ("Confidential Treatment Resolution").

In the July 11 Motion, in reference to the June 26 Resolution, SunEdison reported:

- 1. No third party has been contracted nor is one currently being considered.
- 2. The system is not operational and the requirement to file financial statements should not apply at this moment.

The Energy Bureau **TAKES NOTICE** of the information provided in the July 11 Motion pertaining to the absence of a contracted company. The Energy Bureau **DETERMINES** SunEdison is not required under Section 2.02 (A)(1)(d) of Regulation 8701 to submit the information required in the June 26 Resolution.

The Energy Bureau **TAKES NOTICE** of the status of operation reported by SunEdison and **WAIVES** SunEdison's requirement to submit Financial Statements for Fiscal Year 2024.
