## **RESOLUTION AND ORDER**

On June 26, 2025, the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board ("Energy Bureau") issued a Resolution and Order ("June 26 Resolution") granting the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority ("PREPA") request for extension until June 30, 2025 to comply with the June 3 Resolution and Order in which PREPA was ordered to submit the following documents as required by Section 4.02(G) of Regulation 8701:1

- 1. 2024 Gross Revenue Report, duly certified by PREPA's Executive Director, as required by Section 4.02(G) of Regulation 8701, including the breakdown corresponding to July, August, September, October, November, and December 2024 for the electric services in Puerto Rico.
- 2. Copy of the PREPA financial statements for the 2024 Fiscal Year, if available, or an explanation of their unavailability and expected completion date.

On July 1, 2025, PREPA filed a document titled Motion in Compliance with June 3, 2025, Resolution and Order ("July 1 Motion") with the following documents:

Exhibit A - Resolution 5202 - Approval of Gross Income Report for Calendar Year 2024 by PREPA's Governing Board.

Exhibit B - Certification of Gross Income Report for Calendar Year 2024 by PREPA's Executive Director.

The Gross Income Report for Calendar Year 2024 is not audited. The reason alleged by PREPA for the delay of the audit process is reported in the July 1 Motion. PREPA reports that this is the cause that it is rendering it unable to move forward with the issuance of its FY2023 and FY2024 audited financial statements.

Upon reviewing the July 1 Motion and its Exhibits, the Energy Bureau **TAKES NOTICE** of the information provided and **DETERMINES** PREPA **COMPLIED** with the June 26 Resolution. The Energy Bureau ORDERS PREPA to submit an Informative Motion updating the Energy Bureau on the status of its FY2023 and FY2024 audited financial statements, within fortyfive (45) days from the notification of this Resolution and Order. If they become available before such date, PREPA shall file them immediately.

The Energy Bureau WARNS PREPA that in accordance with Art. 6.36 of Act 57-2014<sup>2</sup>, noncompliance with this Resolution and Order may carry the imposition of fines.
