**RESOLUTION AND ORDER**

On July 10, 2025, the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board (“Energy Bureau”) issued a Resolution and Order (“July 10 Resolution”) granting SunE XVI Lessor, LLC (“SunE XVI”), fifteen (15) days to submit its *Operational Report for Electric Power Companies* (Form NEPR-B03) and evidence of the payment of the corresponding filing fee.

On July 18, 2025, SunE XVI filed a *Certification of Qualifying Facility (QF) Status for a Small Power Production or Cogeneration Facility* of the Federal Regulatory Commission (Form 556).

On July 22, 2025, SunE XVI filed a document titled *Motion to Request Confidential Treatment of 2025 Operational Report* (“July 22 Motion”) accompanied by the following:

Redacted and Unredacted version of the July 22, including redacted and unredacted versions of: *Operational Report for Electric Power Companies* (Form NEPR-B03) as Attachment 1; Statement about the filing before the Energy Public Policy Program as Attachment 2; and evidence of the filing fee for Form NEPR-B03 as Attachment 3.

In Form NEPR-03 SunE XVI reported that their system’s operation is contracted to a third party.

SunE XVI requested confidential treatment of the July 22 Motion and the attachments included. SunE XVI submitted both redacted and unredacted versions of July 22 Motion in compliance with: (i) Section 6.15 of Act 57-2014<sup>1</sup>; (ii) Section 1.15 of Regulation 8701<sup>2</sup>; and (iii) *In Re: Policy on Management of Confidential Information in Procedures before the Commission*, Case No.: CEPR-MI-2016-0009, Resolution and Order issued on August 31, 2016 (“Confidential Treatment Resolution”).

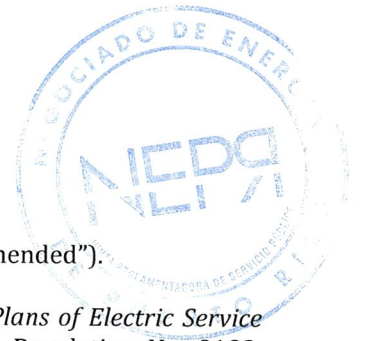
The Energy Bureau **DETERMINES** SunE XVI **COMPLIED** with Section 2.02 of Regulation 8701 that requires filing its *Operational Report for Electric Power Companies* (Form NEPR-B03) and **COMPLIED** with Section 2.03(A)(2) that requires submitting evidence of payment of the applicable filing fee, as required in the July 10 Resolution. In its Operational Report SunE XVI provided the name and contact information of a system operation contractor. Nonetheless, SunE XVI did not provide the credentials of such entity. Therefore, the Energy Bureau **ORDERS** SunE XVI to submit the credentials of the entity contracted to operate its system, within **fifteen (15) days** from the notification of this Resolution and Order.

These credentials, analogous from those required by Regulation 8701 from all electric service companies, must include:

1. Proof of legal personality to operate in Puerto Rico, including:

- a. Name, legal structure (*e.g.*, LLC, corporation), jurisdiction and country of organization;
- b. Certificate of incorporation and registration;
- c. Certificate of good standing issued by the Puerto Rico Department of State (dated within three months of submission);
- d. If a foreign entity, certificate of authorization to do business in Puerto Rico; and
- e. Any additional information required by the Energy Bureau or its forms.

2. Evidence of capacity to operate the contracted services, including:

- a. Summary of operational personnel;
- b. Their technical qualifications and licenses.


Furthermore, the Energy Bureau **ORDERS** SunE XVI to describe what services, equipment, and systems the contracted entity will operate

The Energy Bureau **TAKES NOTICE** of the *Certification of Qualifying Facility (QF) Status for a Small Power Production or Cogeneration Facility* of the Federal Regulatory Commission (Form 556) filed by SunE XVI.

The Energy Bureau **GRANTS** confidential designation and treatment to the July 22 Motion and its Attachments, pursuant to Act 57-2014 and Regulation 8701.

The Energy Bureau **WARNS** SunE XVI that, in accordance with Art. 6.36 of Act 57-2014, non-compliance with this Resolution and Order will carry the imposition of fines.


