REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

TO THE HONORABLE ENERGY BUREAU:

COMES NOW, Global Power Solutions (PR) LLC (“Global Power”), represented by the undersigned legal counsel, and respectfully submits the following showing of cause and request for extension:

1. On June 18, 2025, Global Power submitted before this Honorable Energy Bureau its request for certification as an electric service company, consisting of a Personal Information Form (NEPR-B01) along with supporting documentation, the Operational Report Form (NEPR-B03) and the Request for Certification Form (NEPR-B04) (collectively, the “Application”).
2. On July 16, 2025, the Energy Bureau issued a Resolution and Order (the “July 16 R&O”) determining the Application was incomplete and listing the supporting documentation required pursuant to Sections 2.01 and 3.03 of the *Amendment to Regulation No. 8618 on Certification, Annual Fees, and Operational Plans for Electric Service Companies in Puerto Rico*, Regulation 8701 of February 17, 2016, as amended (“Regulation 8701”), including but not limited to: (1) Certified Financial Statements; (2) Human Resources Statement; (3) Technical Specifications of units and equipment; (4) Permits, authorizations or endorsements required to operate the system; (5) Operational Report Annex including the information required by Section 2.02 of Regulation 8701; (6) evidence of payment of the corresponding filing fees for

the Application; and (7) any additional supporting documentation required by the Bureau or Regulation 8701 (collectively, the “Required Documentation”). Moreover, Global Power was requested to show that the service the petitioner intends to offer will be reliable and will not threaten the safety and reliability of the electrical infrastructure.

3. The Energy Bureau granted Global Power until August 15, 2025 to submit the Required Documentation.
4. Global Power was recently created as a legal entity, as evidenced by the Certificate of Formation of a Limited Liability Company included the Application. As a newly formed entity, it was necessary to undertake a number of foundational steps, including completing various federal, state, and local government registrations, implementing an appropriate governance framework, and securing required governmental certifications which took longer than anticipated despite Global Power’s efforts. Furthermore, updates to our project were requested by the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority and required engineering and design changes which Global Power submitted recently for their review. Lastly, compliance with Regulation 8701 necessitated the preparation and submission of extensive documentation and information, further contributing to an unanticipated extended timeline.
5. Given the foregoing, Global Power hereby respectfully petitions this Honorable Energy Bureau to grant a brief fifteen (15) day extension to submit the Required Documentation.

WHEREFORE, Global Power respectfully requests that this Honorable Energy Bureau grant an a brief fifteen (15) day extension to submit the Required Documentation.
