MOTION IN COMPLIANCE WITH AUGUST 7 RESOLUTION AND ORDER

TO THE HONORABLE ENERGY BUREAU:

COMES NOW, Ligueto Operating PR SA LLC ("Ligueto"), represented by the undersigned legal counsel, and respectfully submits the following:

1. On June 23, 2025 the Energy Bureau issued a Resolution and Order ("June 23 R&O") directing Ligueto to submit the credentials of the entities contracted to operate its systems, as required under Section 2.02 (A)(1)(d) of Regulation 8701
2. On July 8, 2025, Ligueto filed its *Motion in Compliance with June 23 Resolution and Order and Request for Confidential Treatment* ("July 8 Motion"), submitting the requested credentials for Juapi Project Services, LLC (dba Juapi Energy) and FR-BLDM LLC (collectively, the "Sub-Contractors") in compliance with the June 23 R&O.
3. On August 7, 2025, the Bureau issued a Resolution and Order (the "August 7 R&O") determining that Ligueto complied with Section 2.02(A)(1)(d) of Regulation 8701 by submitting the credentials of the entities contracted to operate its systems. Notwithstanding, the Bureau required Ligueto to further describe what services, equipment, and systems the Sub-Contractors will operate.

4. In compliance with the August 7 R&O, Ligueto states as follows: Ligueto offers residential solar-plus-storage systems designed for self-generation and consumption throughout Puerto Rico. Under a U.S. Department of Energy (the “DOE”) grant, for which Generac is the prime recipient and Ligueto a sub-recipient, the DOE identifies eligible beneficiaries and routes them to Ligueto. Ligueto then then assigns the installation work to its Sub-Contractors, Juapi and FR-BLDM. The Sub-Contractors then install solar arrays paired with Generac inverters and batteries. Acting under Ligueto’s direction and standards, the Sub-Contractors perform: site assessments; system design review support; installation and commissioning; configuration of controls and monitoring; initial performance verification; customer orientation; and ongoing field services (including warranty support, preventive maintenance, corrective maintenance, and replacement of failed components). Ligueto retains ownership of the systems and provides ongoing service and maintenance in coordination with Generac and the Sub-Contractors.

WHEREFORE, Ligueto Operating PR SA LLC respectfully moves this Honorable Energy Bureau to take notice of this submission, deem this supplemental description responsive to the August 7 R&O and confirm that Ligueto remains in compliance with Regulation 8701, § 2.02(A)(1)(d)
