**MOTION IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE RESOLUTION AND ORDER DATED JULY 14, 2025
TO THE HONORABLE PUERTO RICO ENERGY BUREAU:**

COMES NOW the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority ("PREPA") through its counsel of record, and respectfully state and pray as follows:

1. On July 14, 2025, the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board ("Energy Bureau") issued a Resolution and Order in the instant proceeding, directing PREPA and Genera PR, LLC ("Genera") to file monthly reports in Case No. NEPR-MI-2020-0001, starting on August 15, 2025. The reports must include: (i) any events or limitations resulting from the inability to switch fuels in the temporary generation units; (ii) the operational consequences of such events; (iii) any claims submitted under the natural gas supply agreement; and (iv) supporting documentation, including internal communications and correspondence between the contracting parties ("July 14 Resolution").

2. On August 15, 2025, PREPA and Genera filed a joint motion requesting an extension until August 22, 2025, to comply with the July 14 Resolution. As indicated in that motion, the information necessary to comply with the reporting obligation

resides with Genera, given its operational role in managing the temporary generation units.

3. On August 18, 2025, the Energy Bureau issued a Resolution and Order granting the requested extension. Following the extension, PREPA continued its efforts to coordinate with Genera to submit the report required by the July 14 Resolution. Notwithstanding these efforts, at approximately 4:33 p.m. on August 22, 2025, Genera's legal counsel informed PREPA that Genera would be submitting a separate motion before the Energy Bureau.

4. In light of this development, and considering that the information required to complete the report is in Genera's possession, PREPA respectfully submits this motion to inform the Energy Bureau of Genera's decision to proceed independently. PREPA expects that Genera will provide the Energy Bureau with the information required under the July 14 Resolution.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons stated above, PREPA respectfully requests that the Energy Bureau take **NOTICE** of the present Motion and **DEEMS** PREPA in compliance with the July 14 Resolution and Order.
