MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO RESPOND TO THE REQUEST FOR CERTIFICATION

TO THE HONORABLE ENERGY BUREAU:

COMES NOW, AES Ilumina, LLC ("AES Ilumina" or the "Company"), represented by the undersigned attorneys, and very respectfully states and prays as follows:

- 1. On August 7, 2025, the Puerto Rico Energy Bureau entered a *Resolution and Order* requiring AES Ilumina to submit the credentials of the entity contracted by the Company to operate its system (the "Request"). The name and contact information of this system operator was initially disclosed by AES Ilumina its *Operational Report for Electric Service Companies*, which was filed with the Energy Bureau on February 28, 2025.
- 2. As per the Resolution and Order, this Request requires AES Ilumina to provide detailed information about the system operator, including information regarding its legal identity, operational qualifications, and a description of the services and systems to be operated.
- 3. AES Ilumina is committed to complying with the Energy Bureau's directives and providing a complete, thorough, and adequate response to the Request. However, given this case was just referred to the undersigned counsel, and due to the broad scope and depth of the Request, AES Ilumina requires additional time to ensure the information provided in its response is adequate and responsive.
 - 4. In particular, this Request requires AES Ilumina to submit, among others:
 - a. Proof of legal personality of the entity and its capacity to do business in Puerto Rico
 (e.g., name, legal structure, incorporation documents, certificate of good standing
 certificate, and authorization to do business if foreign);
 - b. Evidence of operational capacity, including a summary of personnel and their technical qualifications/licenses; and
 - c. A description of the services, equipment, and systems that the contracted entity will operate.

5. Based on the above, and given the scope of the Request and the need to ensure

compliance with the Energy Bureau's mandate, AES Ilumina respectfully requests an extension of

ten (10) business days, until September 5, 2025, to submit its response.

This extension of time is essential to submit a response that is adequate and

responsive to the Request and granting the same will not prejudice the proceedings, as it allows

for the orderly and efficient presentation of the facts necessary to address the matters at issue.

WHEREFORE, AES Ilumina respectfully requests that the Honorable Energy Bureau

takes notice of the above and, consequently: i) grant this Motion and extend the deadline to respond

to the Request for Certification to September 5, 2025; and ii) grant such other and further relief as

the Energy Bureau deems just and proper.
