**RESOLUTION AND ORDER**

On August 7, 2025, the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board ("Energy Bureau") issued a Resolution and Order granting HUMACAO SOLAR PROJECT, LLC. ("Humacao Solar") fifteen (15) days to: (i) submit the credentials<sup>1</sup> of the entity contracted to operate its system as required under Section 2.02 (A)(1)(d) of Regulation 8701<sup>2</sup> and (ii) describe what services, equipment, and systems it will operate.

On August 19, 2025, Humacao Solar filed a document titled *Submission of Contracted Entity Credentials – Fonroche Energy America, Inc.* ("August 19 Motion") with the following documents:

1. Certificate of Registration issued on March 21, 2011, by the Puerto Rico Department of State.
2. Good Standing Certificate issued on August 19, 2025, by the Puerto Rico Department of State.

In the August 19 Motion, Humacao Solar included following description:

The contracted entity is Fonroche Energy America, Inc., a domestic corporation, for-profit, organized under the statutes of Puerto Rico, on March 21 de 2011, and in good standing with the Department of State.

Fonroche Energy America, Inc., provides Humacao Solar Project, LLC with photovoltaic system operation and maintenance services under a contract in force since 2016. Its technical team is made up of engineers and administrators with more than 20 years of experience in the engineering and administration industries, and more than 10 years of specific experience in the renewable energy industry in Puerto Rico.

Section 3.03(A)(4) of Regulation 8701 requires from electric service companies:

A statement as to the fact that the company has the necessary human resources (technical, professional, and administrative) to operate and provide the services it intends to offer in Puerto Rico. The company must also list in detail the technical and professional qualifications of said personnel, as well as the profile of those it intends to recruit in order to show their expertise and competency to operate and provide the services the company intends to offer in Puerto Rico.

<sup>1</sup> The required credentials include: (i) proof of legal personality to operate in Puerto Rico and, (ii) evidence of capacity to operate the contracted services, including a summary of operational personnel, their technical qualifications and licenses, as described in the Resolution.


When the operation of the system is delegated to a contracted entity the required evidence must be submitted for that operator.

The Energy Bureau **TAKES NOTICE** of the information and documents filed by Humacao Solar with the August 19 Motion. The Energy Bureau **DETERMINES** Humacao Solar **COMPLIED PARTIALLY** with the August 7 Resolution.

The Energy Bureau **GRANTS** Humacao Solar **fifteen (15) days** from the notification of this Resolution to list in detail the technical and professional qualifications of the contracted entity personnel.

The Energy Bureau **WARNS** Humacao Solar that failure to comply with this Resolution and Order will result in the imposition of fines in accordance with Section 6.36 of Act 57-2014.<sup>3</sup>


