RESOLUTION

On August 12, 2025, the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board (“Energy Bureau”) issued a Resolution and Order (“August 12 Resolution”) granting SunE XVI Lessor, LLC (“SunE XVI”) fifteen (15) days to: (i) submit the credentials<sup>1</sup> of the entity contracted to operate its system as required under Section 2.02 (A)(1)(d) of Regulation 8701<sup>2</sup>, and (ii) describe what services, equipment, and systems it will operate.

On August 27, 2025, SunE XVI filed a document titled *Motion in Compliance with August 12 Resolution and Order* (“August 27 Motion”), through which it submitted, as Attachment 1, information and credentials of the contracted entity, including proof of legal personality to operate in Puerto Rico and evidence of its capacity to operate the system. SunE XVI further submitted information of the services, equipment, and systems that the contracted entity will operate. SunE XVI requested confidential treatment of the August 27 Motion and, and the documents attached to it. SunE XVI submitted redacted and unredacted versions of the August 27 Motion and its attachments, all in compliance with: (i) Section 6.15 of Act 57-2014<sup>3</sup>; (ii) Section 1.15 of Regulation 8701; and (iii) *In Re: Policy on Management of Confidential Information in Procedures before the Commission*, Case No.: CEPR-MI-2016-0009, Resolution and Order issued on August 31, 2016 (“Confidential Treatment Resolution”).

Upon reviewing the August 27 Motion, the Energy Bureau **DETERMINES** SunE XVI **COMPLIED** with Section 2.02 (A)(1)(d) of Regulation 8701 submitting the credentials of the entity contracted to operate its system and describing what services, equipment, and systems it will operate.

The Energy Bureau **GRANTS** confidential designation and treatment to the August 27 Motion and the attached documents, under Act 57-2014 and Regulation 8701.



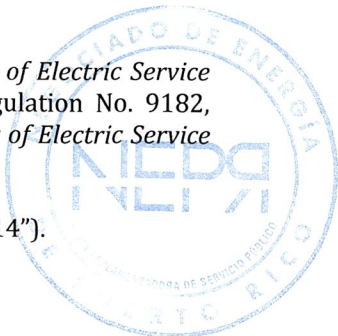
