RESOLUTION AND ORDER

On August 7 2025, the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board ("Energy Bureau") issued a Resolution and Order ("August 7 Resolution") granting AES Ilumina, LLC ("AES Ilumina") fifteen (15) days to: (i) submit the credentials¹ of the entity contracted to operate its system as required under Section 2.02 (A)(1)(d) of Regulation 8701² and (ii) describe what services, equipment, and systems it will operate.

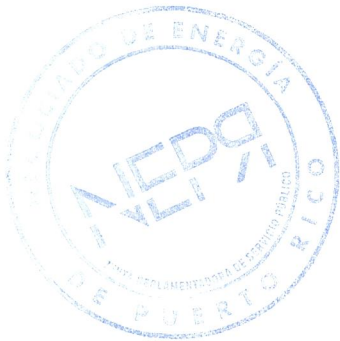
On August 22, 2025, AES Ilumina filed a document titled *Motion for Extension of Time to Respond to the Request for Certification* ("August 22 Motion") requesting ten (10) additional days and/or until September 5, 2025, to comply with the August 7 Resolution.

On August 29, 2025, the Energy Bureau issued a Resolution and Order ("August 29 Resolution") granting AES Ilumina until September 5, 2025, to comply with the August 7 Resolution.

On September 4, 2025, AES Ilumina filed before the Energy Bureau a document titled *Motion for Additional Extension of Time to Submit Response to Request for Certification* ("September 4 Motion"), whereby it requested twenty (20) additional days and/or until September 25, 2025, to comply with the August 7 Resolution.

Upon reviewing the September 4 Motion, the Energy Bureau **GRANTS** AES Ilumina until **Thursday, September 25, 2025**, to comply with the August 7 Resolution.

The Energy Bureau **WARNS** AES Ilumina that failure to comply with this Resolution and Order will result in the imposition of fines under Section 6.36 of Act 57-2014³.



¹ The required credentials include: (i) proof of legal personality to operate in Puerto Rico and, (ii) evidence of capacity to operate the contracted services, including a summary of operational personnel, their technical qualifications and licenses, as described in the August 7 Resolution.


